Pro Career Highlights: Spent the 2006-07 season with Casino Figueira Ginasio in the Portugese UZO League, averaging 13.8 points and 7.3 rebounds in 32 games. Started the 2005-06 season in Portugal with Santarem Basket, averaging 11.5 points and 10.7 rebounds in ten games before moving on to play for TSV Crailsheim Merlins in the German 2.Bundesliga, averaging 8.7 points and 5.2 rebounds in 15 games. Earned Portuguese League All-Star Game honors in 2005-06 and 2006-07.

College Highlights: Started 70 of 114 career games.

Senior (2004-05): Averaged 5.3 points and 4.2 rebounds in 20.4 minutes a contest. Started 24 of 27 games. Scored in double figures six times. Recorded season highs of 21 points and five assists vs. Montana Tech. Tallied 14 points and six rebounds at Southern Utah. Posted a double-double of 13 points and a season-high 13 rebounds at Utah Valley State. Tallied 13 points and nine rebounds vs. Northern Arizona. Scored ten points at Oregon in the season opener.

Junior (2003-04): Averaged 6.5 points and 4.5 rebounds in 23.3 minutes a contest. Started all 31 games. Scored in double figures eight times. Registered season-high 16 points vs. Montana. Recorded 15 points vs. Montana-Western. Tallied 12 points and seven rebounds vs. Texas Southern. Pulled down a season-high nine rebounds vs. Eastern Washington.

Sophomore (2002-03): Averaged 2.3 points and 2.1 rebounds in 10.6 minutes a contest. Started four times. Hit all four field goal attempts in scoring a season-high eight points vs. Montana. Grabbed a season-high six rebounds vs. Tennessee Tech.

Redshirt Freshman (2001-02): Averaged 3.7 points and 2.7 rebounds in 15.8 minutes a contest. Started 11 times. Scored in double figures three times. Set season high with ten points at Utah State. Posted ten points and seven rebounds vs. Portland State. Gathered a season-high ten rebounds vs. Montana. Blocked a season-high three shots at Southern Utah.
