**College Highlights:** Played in 128 career games for American and started in all but six games ... led the team in scoring all four years and finished his collegiate career averaging 13.8 points, 6.3 rebounds, 1.0 assists in 29.7 minutes of play.

**Senior (2006-07):** Played in 35 games, earning 35 starts ... averaged 15.3 points, 7.0 rebounds and 1.4 assists in 31.8 minutes per game ... voted First-team All-Horizon League for the second straight season, after being chosen to the preseason all-league First Team ... First-Team All-District 12 by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) ... averaged 31.9 minutes a game ... Has led the team in scoring in each season and is only the third player to accomplish the feat in four straight years (Franklin Edwards, 1977-81) and Weldon Kytte, 1961-65).

**Junior (2005-06):** First team All-Horizon League selection after ranking sixth in the league with a 14.8 scoring average ... named honorable mention Mid-Major All-American by CollegeHoops.net ... finished ninth in the Horizon League shooting .774 from the free throw line (147-190), including a school-record tying 13-for-13 effort against USF (11/9/07) ... averaged 18.8 points and 7.8 rebounds over the last 10 games, shooting .488 (63-129) from the field ... Horizon League All-Tournament team choice after averaging 20.0 points and 8.5 rebounds in two tourney games ... led CSU with 21 points and nine rebounds in Horizon League championship game vs. Butler. (3/11/08) ... scored 19 points with eight rebounds vs. Valparaiso in Horizon League semi-finals (3/8/08) ... named to the Glenn Wilkes Classic All-Tournament team after averaging 21.3 points and 7.8 rebounds in four games.

**Sophomore (2004-05):** Played in 31 games earning 31 starts ... averaged 13.5 points in 30.8 minutes of play ... became only the third player in the 76-year history of the program to lead the team in scoring as both a freshman and sophomore, joining Franklin Edwards (1977-81) and Weldon Kytte (1961-65) in accomplishing the feat ... improved his passing skills each year, handing out 38 assists as a junior, 36 as a sophomore and just nine in 2005-06 ... Scored 17 points with a career-high 14 rebounds and 5 assists vs. West Virginia Tech (12/30/06) ... tallied 23 points at Central Michigan (12/17/06), including 21 in the second half and overtime.

**Freshman (2003-04):** Started all but six games in 2005-06, becoming only the fifth freshman to lead the team in scoring (11.3) ... Scored a career-high 25 points vs. UIC (2/22/06), the most points by a CSU frosh since 1996-97 ... came off the bench in games at Detroit, Loyola and Butler, averaging 14.7 points and shooting .640 from the field (16-25) ... scored 21 points at Kent State (12/3/05), setting a Viking freshman record with 20 free throws attempted.

**Personal:** son of Jimmie Bullock and Phyllis Lakes. ... is the youngest of three children, having one brother and one sister. ... was a member of the Honor Roll for all four years in high school, graduating with a 3.2 gpa. ... mechanical engineering major.
