College Highlights: Played and started in all 136 games while at Georgetown ... averaged 9.2 points, 2.3 rebounds and 2.8 assists.

Senior (2007-08): An honorable mention All-BIG EAST selection ... Third on the team with 10.7 points, 2.6 assists and 2.1 rebounds per game ... Scored a career-high 26 points - tying a career mark with six three-pointers - in a loss at Syracuse ... Passed Kevin Braswell to become the Hoyas' all-time three-point field goal leader against Fordham (12/31/07); leaves school with 240 all-time three-pointers ... Became the 39th player in program history with at least 1,000 points against Fordham (12/31/07).

Junior (2006-07): Played and started in 27 games averaging 17.4 points, 2.7 rebounds and 3.1 assists per game ... Scored a career-high 21 points and grabbed three rebounds at Seton Hall ... Second on the team with 15 points - on 5-for-7 shooting from the field, including 2-for-3 from behind the arc - in the second round NCAA Tournament win over Boston College ... Scored all eight of his points in the second half, handed out four assists and had three rebounds in the Sweet 16 against Vanderbilt ... Hit a clutch three-pointer with 31.9 seconds remaining in regulation to tie the game and send it into overtime in the Hoyas win over North Carolina in the Elite Eight; he scored 19 points on 7-for-11 shooting from the field, including 3-for-4 from behind the arc, and added a career-best seven assists ... Scored 19 points, hitting a season-high five three-pointers, in the NCAA Semifinals against Ohio State.

Sophomore (2005-06): Played and started in 33 games averaging 7.9 points, 2.4 rebounds and 3.2 assists ... Fifth on the team in scoring and led the team in assists ... Has scored in double-digits 14 times ... Shot .457 percent from the floor (86-of-188) and .427 percent from outside the arc (47-of-110) ... Scored eight points, had six rebounds and four assists in BIG EAST Tournament win over Notre Dame ... Had 10 points, tied a season-high with six assists and grabbed three boards in BIG EAST Semifinals against Syracuse.

Freshman (2004-05): Started every contest, averaging 30.4 minutes per game ... averaged 6.5 points, 2.2 assists, 2.1 rebounds and 1.2 steals ... set a career high in scoring with 20 points at Davidson ... established career high in steals with four vs. St. John's ... set career high in rebounding with four on three occasions ... twice posted six-assist performances ... shot 78.8 percent from the free-throw stripe.
