**Pro Career Highlights:** Split the 2007-08 season in the NBA Developmental League between the Bakersfield Jam and Iowa Energy, averaging 6.5 points and 1.5 rebounds in 46 total games. Spent the summer of 2007 playing with Tri Valley in the IBL (statistics unavailable). Played with the Great Falls Explorers in the CBA in 2006-07, averaging 11.0 points and 2.8 rebounds in 42 games. Split the summer of 2006 between the Tri-City Ballers of the IBL, averaging 24.6 points in 15 games, and Tijuana Galgos in the Mexican League (statistics unavailable). Played with the San Francisco Pilots in the ABA in 2005-06 (statistics unavailable). Spent the summer of 2005 with the San Jose Ballers in the IBL, leading the league in scoring (35.3 ppg) in 17 games.

**College Highlights:** Finished collegiate career at San Francisco after playing first two seasons at St. Mary's (Calif.). Attended Contra Costa College in San Pablo, California during the 2001-02 season, but did not play.

**Senior (2003-04):** Averaged 7.3 points and 2.4 rebounds in 24.9 minutes a contest. Started 18 of 28 games. Scored in double figures 11 times. Recorded season-high 18 points vs. San Diego. Tallied 11 points and season highs with nine rebounds and five assists vs. Ohio State. Registered 14 points, five rebounds, two assists, two blocks, and two steals in the season opener vs. Tennessee-Martin. Scored 14 points vs. Richmond. Posted 13 points and eight rebounds at Loyola Marymount.

**Junior (2002-03):** Averaged 4.4 points and 1.6 rebounds in 15.9 minutes a contest. Started four times. Scored in double figures five times. Registered season-high 17 points at Pepperdine. Tallied 14 points in the season opener vs. Seton Hall. Scored 13 points vs. Fresno State. Tallied ten points and four assists vs. Nevada.

**Sophomore (2000-01):** At St. Mary's, averaged 15.1 points (ranked fifth in the WCC) and 3.2 rebounds. Also ranked third in the league in free throw percentage (.782). Started 21 of 29 games. Recorded career highs of 31 points and ten rebounds at Portland. Registered 25 points vs. Loyola Marymount. Scored 22 points vs. Santa Clara.

**Freshman (1999-00):** Averaged 7.0 points and 3.6 rebounds in 24.2 minutes a contest. Started nine times. Scored in double figures seven times, posting a season-high 16 points vs. Wright State.
