**Pro Career Highlights:** Split the 2006-07 season between Spain and Italy. Played with Grupo Capitol Valladolid in Spain, averaging 0.5 points and 1.0 rebounds in two games. Moved on to Livorno in Italy, appearing in seven games and averaging 3.9 points and 2.3 rebounds in 15.1 minutes a contest. Selected by Colorado 14ers in the fourth round (46<sup>th</sup> pick overall) of 2006 NBA Developmental League Draft. Participated in NBA summer league with the Golden State Warriors in the summer of 2006.

**College Highlights:** Earned First Team All-WAC honors as a senior. Ranks as the ninth all-time leading scorer in school history with 1,230 points. Also ranks in the top ten in field goals made (457, seventh), three-point field goals made (102, eighth), free throws made (214, ninth), rebounds (598, seventh), assists (289, ninth), steals (108, ninth), and blocked shots (69, tenth). Finished collegiate career at Hawaii after playing freshman season at Los Angeles City College. Started 86 of 89 career games. Did not play basketball during the 2001-02 season, but attended several schools during the school year. Originally signed with California out of high school, but did not qualify academically. Was briefly enrolled at Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Hill, California, Iona, Fresno State, and Community College of Southern Nevada in Las Vegas before surfacing at Los Angeles City College.

**Senior (2005-06):** Averaged a team-high 17.6 points (ranked fifth in the WAC), 5.8 rebounds (tenth), and 3.2 assists (eighth). Started all 27 games, missing one game due to an Achilles injury. Scored 20 or more points ten times. Recorded career-high 32 points at New Mexico State. Shot 10-for-15 from the field in scoring 28 points vs. UNLV. Sank five threes on his way to 25 points and nine rebounds vs. San Jose State. Posted a 15-point, season-high 11-rebound double-double at Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Scored 21 points and dished out a season-high six assists vs. Fresno State.

**Junior (2004-05):** Averaged 12.0 points, 6.9 rebounds, and 3.1 assists. Started 26 of 29 games. Scored in double figures 19 times and posted four 20-point games. Registered five double-doubles. Recorded season-high 23 points twice, vs. St. Mary's and at Fresno State. Tallied 15 points and 11 rebounds at St. Louis. Notched 17 points and 11 rebounds vs. Southern Illinois. Posted 22 points, eight rebounds, and six assists at San Jose State. Played every minute of the game in six contests.

**Sophomore (2003-04):** Averaged 12.3 points, 7.3 rebounds, and 3.4 assists. Ranked in the top ten in the league in rebounding and assists. Started all 33 games. Recorded seven double-doubles. Registered season-high 24 points on 9-for-10 shooting at Fresno State. Tallied 20 points and 11 rebounds at Rice and notched 21 points and eight assists in the rematch. Scored 20 points and grabbed 13 rebounds at Tulsa. Played every minute of the game in eight contests, including all 50 minutes in a double-overtime win at Tulsa.

**Freshman (2002-03):** At Los Angeles City College, averaged 13.4 points and 7.8 rebounds while shooting 52.8 percent from the field. Helped lead team to a 36-2 record and the California Community College Championship. Named First Team All-State.
