**Pro Career Highlights:** Played with the Boston Celtics, Cleveland Cavaliers, and Philadelphia 76ers in the NBA from 2001-02 to 2004-05. In 2004-05 with Philadelphia, missed most of the season due to a lower back strain. Appeared in eight games and averaged 1.5 points and 1.4 rebounds in 6.9 minutes a contest. Split the 2003-04 season with Boston and Cleveland after being traded in mid-season. In 21 games with Boston, averaged 5.2 points and 3.2 rebounds in 19.4 minutes a contest. In 34 games with Cleveland, averaged 5.3 points and 2.3 rebounds in 16.5 minutes a contest. With Boston in 2002-03, averaged 2.8 points and 2.7 rebounds in 13.1 minutes a contest. Started five of 51 games. In rookie campaign with Boston in 2001-02, averaged 2.2 points and 1.7 rebounds in 8.4 minutes a contest. Started five of 29 games. NBA career highs are 18 points (vs. New Jersey in 2003-04) and ten rebounds (at Milwaukee in 2002-03). Selected after sophomore season by Boston in first round (11<sup>th</sup> pick overall) of 2001 NBA Draft.

**College Highlights:** Earned NJCAA First Team All-American honors as a sophomore. Named First Team Panhandle Conference his freshman and sophomore years. Helped lead Okaloosa-Walton to a 55-10 record during his two seasons, with a sixth place finish in the NJCAA Tournament his sophomore year.

**Sophomore (2000-01):** Averaged 22.9 points, 8.8 rebounds, 3.0 assists, 2.3 blocked shots, and 2.3 steals. Scored 20 or more points 19 times. Registered season-high 37 points vs. Pensacola JC. Tallied 32 points in the NJCAA Tournament vs. Schoolcraft. Earned NJCAA All-Tournament honors. Team finished with a 29-5 record.

**Freshman (1999-00):** Averaged 16.6 points, 10.6 rebounds, 4.5 blocked shots, and 3.7 assists. Helped lead team to a 26-5 record.
