College Highlights: Earned Second Team All-Big East honors as a senior. Also named All-District by the NABC and USBWA. Earned Honorable Mention All-Big East honors as a sophomore. Finished collegiate career as Seton Hall's 16<sup>th</sup> all-time leading scorer with 1,459 points. Also ranks eighth in rebounds (761), ninth in games started (108), and sixth in minutes played (3,633). Posted 17 career double-doubles. Originally signed with Michigan in the fall of 2000, but did not qualify academically and headed to prep school. Enrolled at Seton Hall in the spring of 2002 and redshirted.

Senior (2005-06): Averaged 15.2 points (ranked 15<sup>th</sup> in the Big East) and a team-high 7.9 rebounds (sixth). Started all 30 games. Registered four double-doubles. Scored 20 or more points ten times. Posted career-high 29 points and grabbed ten rebounds at Rutgers. Tallied 21 points and a season-high 12 rebounds vs. West Virginia. Scored 25 points in the season opener vs. Manhattan. Registered 18 points and 11 rebounds vs. Cincinnati. Led team with 18 points vs. Wichita State in the first round of the post-season NIT.

Junior (2004-05): Averaged 12.3 points and a team-high 6.2 rebounds (ranked 14<sup>th</sup> in the Big East). Started 25 of 27 games. Scored 20 or more points three times, registering a season-high 27 points vs. St. Peter's. Posted five double-doubles, including a 15-point, season-high 13-rebound effort vs. Monmouth. Posted 16 points and ten rebounds vs. Notre Dame. Scored 21 points vs. Villanova. Recorded 21 points in the season opener vs. Richmond.

Sophomore (2003-04): Averaged 13.6 points and a team-high 6.9 rebounds. Ranked second in the Big East in field goal percentage (.562). Started 23 of 25 games, missing the first semester due to academic ineligibility. Scored 20 or more points five times, registering a season-high 25 points vs. La Salle. Posted four double-doubles. Recorded 20 points and seven rebounds at Miami (Fla.). Tallied 21 points and eight rebounds vs. Syracuse. Led team with 20 points and eight rebounds vs. Villanova in the first round of the Big East Tournament. Scored 24 points and grabbed a season-high 14 rebounds vs. Arizona in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Freshman (2002-03): Averaged 11.0 points and a team-high 6.1 rebounds. Started all 30 games. Scored 20 or more points three times and posted four double-doubles. Scored a season-high 23 points and grabbed ten rebounds at Syracuse. Posted 20 points vs. Louisville. Registered 12 points and a season-high 14 rebounds at Notre Dame. Recorded back-to-back double-doubles with 17 points and ten rebounds at West Virginia and 16 points and ten rebounds at Rutgers.
