Pro Career Highlights: Participated in NBA training camp with the Charlotte Bobcats in the fall of 2006. Spent the 2005-06 season with the Bobcats, averaging 1.8 points and 1.2 assists in 8.7 minutes a contest. Appeared in 39 games with one start. Recorded a career-high 11 points at Miami and a career-high seven assists at San Antonio. Spent the 2004-05 season in Germany with Tubingen, averaging 14.3 points, 3.8 rebounds, and 1.9 assists. Played with USC Heidelberg in the German 2.Bundesliga in 2003-04, averaging 20.8 points, 4.3 rebounds, and 5.9 assists in 30 games.

College Highlights: Finished collegiate career ranked second in Minnesota history with 440 assists. Also ranks third all-time in three-point field goals made (148) and fourth in career steals (157). Scored in double figures 33 times. Started 84 of 123 career games. Sat out the 1998-99 season at Minnesota as a redshirt.

Senior (2002-03): Averaged 6.7 points, 3.1 rebounds, and 4.8 assists. Started 32 of 33 games. Scored in double figures ten times. Scored season-high 17 points vs. Oral Roberts, hitting all four three-point field goal attempts. Tallied 16 points, six assists, and four steals vs. Northwestern and posted 12 points, seven assists, and five steals in the rematch. Scored 14 points vs. Georgia. Dished out a season-high ten assists vs. Georgia Tech. Grabbed a season-high six steals vs. Penn State. Recorded 11 points and seven assists at Temple in the quarterfinals of the post-season NIT. Registered ten points and five assists vs. Georgetown in the NIT semifinals.

Junior (2001-02): Averaged 6.5 points, 2.2 rebounds, and 4.7 assists. Started 19 of 31 games. Scored in double figures six times. Recorded a career-high 24 points at Purdue. Dished out a career-high 11 assists vs. UNC-Asheville. Scored 19 points vs. Michigan. Tallied 12 points and four assists at Wake Forest. Scored 16 points vs. Penn State in the first round of the Big Ten Tournament. Registered ten points vs. Illinois in the semifinals.

Sophomore (2000-01): Averaged 6.3 points, 1.7 rebounds, and 2.5 assists. Started ten of 31 games. Scored in double figures seven times. Registered 16 points vs. Michigan State. Tallied 14 points, including four three-pointers, and four assists at Wisconsin. Distributed a season-high six assists at Marquette. Scored ten points at Florida State. Recorded a season-high 21 points on 8-for-14 shooting vs. Villanova in the first round of the post-season NIT.

Freshman (1999-00): Averaged 8.8 points, 2.6 rebounds, and 2.0 assists. Started 23 of 28 games. Scored in double figures ten times. Recorded season-high 23 points on 8-for-16 shooting, including 5-for-11 from three-point range, at Nebraska. Scored 11 points and dished out a season-high seven assists vs. Morehead State. Posted 16 points and six rebounds in his college debut vs. Texas-Arlington. Registered 15 points vs. Illinois. Notched 14 points and five assists at Iowa.

Personal: Older brother, Nate, is a wide receiver in the NFL with the Seattle Seahawks. Younger brother, Lyndale, is a guard at Nevada.
