College Highlights: Finished collegiate career as Arizona's tenth all-time leading shot blocker with 82 rejections. Started 30 of 102 career games.

Redshirt Senior (2007-08): Averaged 0.8 points, 1.3 rebounds, and 0.5 blocked shots in 7.0 minutes a contest. Started four times. Registered season-highs of four points and four blocked shots in 25 minutes at Memphis. Pulled down a season-high five rebounds and blocked two shots vs. Cal State Fullerton. Grabbed four boards in seven minutes vs. California.

Senior (2006-07): Appeared in two games in a total of three minutes and did not score. Missed the majority of the season due to mononucleosis and a concussion. Received a medical redshirt for an extra year of eligibility.

Junior (2005-06): Averaged 6.1 points, 3.5 rebounds, and 1.5 blocked shots in 18.8 minutes a contest. Started 26 of 33 games. Scored in double figures six times. Posted career-high 18 points on 8-for-11 shooting and matched a career-high with eight rebounds vs. Oregon. Hit all six field goal attempts on his way to 14 points at UCLA. Tallied 13 points, seven rebounds, and two blocked shots in the season opener vs. Kansas. Registered nine points, five rebounds, and a career-high five blocked shots at Arizona State. Blocked four shots on three other occasions. Scored six points and grabbed four rebounds vs. Wisconsin in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Sophomore (2004-05): Averaged 2.4 points, 1.4 rebounds, and 0.7 blocked shots in 9.8 minutes a contest. Sat out the first 15 games of the season with the intention of redshirting before deciding to play. Posted five points, five rebounds, and two blocked shots vs. UCLA. Scored six points at USC. Posted season-high eight points and grabbed three rebounds vs. UAB in the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

Freshman (2003-04): Averaged 0.9 points and 0.8 rebounds in 5.6 minutes a contest. Scored a season-high six points and grabbed three rebounds vs. Cal. Posted four points and a season-high four rebounds in his collegiate debut vs. Northern Arizona. Hit all four free throw attempts in scoring four points vs. Washington.

Personal: Graduated with a degree in health education. Is an avid outdoorsman who enjoys bow hunting, hiking, camping, and playing acoustic guitar.
