**Pro Career Highlights:** Spent the 2006-07 season in the NBA Developmental League with the Austin Toros, averaging 8.5 points and 4.9 rebounds in 43 games. Previously spent a number of seasons in Italy, playing in both the Legabasket (first division) and Legadue (second division) leagues. In 2005-06, played with Pepsi Caserta in the Legadue, averaging 13.4 points and 6.6 rebounds in 26 games. Played with Banca Nuova Trapani in the Legadue in 2004-05, averaging 14.1 points and 6.9 rebounds in 29 games. Spent the 2003-04 season in the United States in the XBL with the Austin Cyclones (statistics unavailable). Played with Pompea Napoli in the Legabasket in 2002-03, averaging 11.5 points and 3.3 rebounds in 21 games. Spent the 2001-02 season with Bipop-Carire Reggio Emilia in the Legadue in 2000-01, averaging 14.9 points and 5.8 rebounds in 36 games. In 2000-01, played with Bipop in the Legabasket, averaging 17.5 points and 4.3 rebounds in 36 games. Spent the 1999-00 season in the IBL with the San Diego Stingrays, averaging 11.5 points and 4.4 rebounds. Selected by the Boston Celtics in the second round (#55 pick overall) of the 1999 NBA Draft.

**College Highlights:** Earned Second Team All-Big 12 honors his junior and senior seasons. Finished collegiate career as the seventh all-time leading scorer in Texas history with 1,592 points. Also ranked fourth in rebounds (771), second in steals (239), and tied for fourth in blocked shots (101). Started 107 of 120 career games.
