Pro Career Highlights: Spent the 2006-07 season in Switzerland with Lausanne Morges Basket, averaging 17.5 points and 8.0 rebound in 11 games. Played in Luxembourg with Residence Walferdange (statistics unavailable) and the Toledo ICE in the ABA (statistics unavailable) during the 2005-06 season. Participated in NBA summer league with the New York Knicks in 2005. Played with the Kentucky Reach in the WBA in the summer of 2005, averaging 22.9 points and 8.5 rebounds in eight games.

College Highlights: Earned First Team All-Mid-South Conference and Second Team NAIA All-American honors as a senior. Finished collegiate career at Georgetown College in Kentucky after playing first two seasons at Mott Community college in Flint, Michigan and spending one year at Clemson. Enrolled at Clemson in the spring of 2003 but did not play.

Senior (2004-05): Averaged 15.5 points and 4.7 rebounds. Became eligible to play in January and appeared in 20 games. Exploded for a career-high 36 points vs. Ohio State-Marion. Posted two double-doubles, including a 21-point, career-high 11-rebound performance vs. Pikeville. Scored 25 points and grabbed seven rebounds vs. Cincinnati-Clermont. Registered 21 points on 10-for-14 shooting vs. Robert Morris (Ill.) in the quarterfinals of the NAIA Tournament.

Junior (2003-04): At Clemson, averaged 4.0 points and 2.6 rebounds in 14.9 minutes a contest. Scored in double figures four times. Recorded season-high 14 points vs. Georgia. Tallied 11 points and five rebounds at Purdue. Scored 11 points vs. Duke. Grabbed season-high six rebounds vs. Virginia. Posted 11 points and five rebounds vs. Virginia in the first round of the ACC Tournament.

Sophomore (2001-02): At Mott CC, averaged 16.0 points, 7.1 rebounds, and 1.3 blocked shots. Earned All-Conference, All-Region, and All-State honors. Named an Honorable Mention All-American.

Freshman (2000-01): Averaged 18.4 points and 5.6 rebounds. Ranked second on the team in scoring and rebounding. Earned All-Conference, All-Region, and All-State honors. Helped lead team to a runner-up finish at the NJCAA Division II Tournament.
