Pro Career Highlights: Participated in NBA summer league with the Houston Rockets in 2008.

College Highlights: Earned Third Team All-Conference USA and NABC Second Team All-Region honors as a junior. Finished collegiate career as Houston's 32nd all-time leading scorer with 1,250 points.

Redshirt Senior (2007-08): Averaged 5.5 points, 1.5 rebounds, and 3.7 assists (ranked eighth in C-USA). Also ranked third in the league in free throw percentage (.833). Started 22 of 29 games. Scored in double figures six times, recording a season-high 16 points in consecutive games vs. Central Florida and at UTEP. Distributed out a season-high ten assists vs. Marshall. Tallied 11 points and eight assists vs. Kentucky.

Senior (2006-07): Averaged 7.8 points, 2.3 rebounds, and 3.0 assists, appearing in four games before sitting out the rest of the season recovering from pre-season surgery on his left foot. Posted season-highs of 12 points and six assists at Arizona. Tallied nine points and four assists vs. UNLV in last appearance of the season. Granted a medical redshirt after the season for an extra year of eligibility.

Junior (2005-06): Averaged 12.1 points, 2.6 rebounds, and 5.4 assists (fourth in C-USA). Started all 30 games. Scored 20 or more points four times. Registered a season-high 25 points and added nine assists at Central Florida. Recorded first career double-double with 11 points and ten assists vs. Virginia Commonwealth. Set a career-high with 11 assists vs. Arizona. Sank six threes on his way to 20 points and eight assists at East Carolina. Narrowly missed a triple-double with nine points, ten rebounds, and a career-high-tying 11 assists vs. BYU in the first round of the post-season NIT.

Sophomore (2004-05): Averaged 14.7 points, 2.4 rebounds, and 4.2 assists (fifth in C-USA). Also ranked sixth in the league in three-point field goal percentage (.402) and seventh in three-point field goals made per game (2.5). Started all 32 games. Scored 20 or more points nine times, posting season-high 30 points vs. New Orleans. Tallied 26 points at Texas A&M. Recorded 24 points at TCU and notched 16 points and nine assists in the rematch. Dished out a season-high ten assists vs. SE Louisiana.

Freshman (2003-04): Averaged 8.4 points, 2.1 rebounds, and a team-high 3.2 assists. Started 26 of 27 games. Scored in double figures ten times. Registered a career-high 31 points, hitting 5-for-9 from three-point range vs. Southern Miss. Posted 19 points vs. LSU. Recorded 15 points and four assists vs. South Florida. Dished out a season-high six assists in games vs. Bethune-Cookman and Lamar.
