**College Highlights:** Honorable Mention All-Big Ten in 2007 ... set Minnesota's season record for three-pointers with 78 in 2006-07, and then broke the record again during the 2007-08 season with 79 threes ... also attempted a school record 207 treys in 2006-07 ... scored in double figures 77 times in his career ..... named to Big 12's All-Reserve Team in 2004-05 ... has 15 20-point games in his career ... played in his 100th career game against South Dakota State (12/12), his 39th as a Gopher ... made 157 treys as a Gopher, third on Minnesota's career list ... finished with 391 three-point attempts as a Gopher, fourth on Minnesota's top-10 career list.

**Senior (2007-08):** Played in 34 games earning 29 starts ... recorded 100th career steal in win over Indiana (3/14) ... a season-high 31 minutes and tied a season-high by dishing out six assists vs. Northwestern (1/9) ... poured in a career-high 26 points against Michigan (2/21), his seven three-pointers against the Wolverines tied a school record ... scored his 1,300th career point in win over Penn State on Feb. 24, 2008 ... named to the All-Big Ten Third Team by the coaches in 2007-08 and All-Big Ten Honorable Mention by the media.

**Junior (2006-07):** Played in all 31 games, starting 28 ... ranked seventh in the Big Ten in scoring (14.9) and eighth in conference games (14.8) ... also ranked fourth in three-point field goals made (2.52 per game) ... ranked 15th overall in assists (2.77) ... had his third straight 20-point effort, going 4-of-9 from the floor and 9-of-10 from the line in 37 minutes at Indiana registered his second double-double of his career with 22 points, on 9-of-16 from the field, 3-of-7 from three-point range, with 10 assists and five rebounds in 39 minutes vs. Ohio State (2/18) ... 2005-06: Redshirted after transferring from Oklahoma.

**Sophomore (2004-05) Oklahoma:** Came off the bench in 26 of 32 games ... named to Big 12's All-Reserve Team averaged 9.5 points, 1.2 assists and 1.0 steal per contest ... 74 three-point shots to average 2.3 per game. ... made at least two three-point shots in 23 games, at least three 14 times, at least four in seven contests and five on three made 13 threes on 26 attempts during a three-game span to occasions ... grabbed a season-high six rebounds in just 19 minutes against Florida A&M ... recorded a career-high four steals in home win over Texas A&M (2/2) ... registered a career-high five assists at Iowa State (1/29).

**Freshman (2003-04) Oklahoma:** Played in 29 of team's 31 games (missed two December with a stress fracture in his foot) ... started in 20 contests... averaged 8.2 points per game (ranked also fourth on team)... averaged 2.3 rebounds, 1.2 assists and 0.7 steals on the year in 21.7 minutes per game ... shot .759 from the free-throw line ... ranked second on the team with 45 three-pointers (1.6 per game) and shot .321 from beyond the arc ... made at least one three-pointer in 21 games and had multiple three-pointers in 12 games named to Sooner Invitational all-tournament team ... recorded a season-high four assists twice.
