Three-point field goals: 2003-04, 57-for-151 (.377); 2004-05, 47-for-154 (.305); 2005-06, 72-for-180 (.400); 2006-07, 85-for-198 (.429). Totals: 261-for-683 (.382).

College Highlights: Finished collegiate career as Georgia's all-time leader in three-point field goals made (261) and attempted (683). Also ranks 12th all-time in career scoring with 1,383 points. Started 111 of 115 career games.

Senior (2006-07): Averaged 12.5 points and 2.5 rebounds. Ranked fourth in the SEC in three-point field goals made (2.7), fourth in three-point field goal percentage (.429), and fifth in steals (1.8 spg). Started 30 of 32 games. Hit 7-for-9 from three-point range on his way to 27 points vs. Jacksonville. Tallied 25 points vs. Gonzaga. Scored 23 points vs. Vanderbilt. Tallied 21 points and four assists vs. Mississippi State. Registered 22 points vs. Auburn in the first round of the SEC Tournament. Exploded for season-high 30 points on 11-for-14 shooting, including 8-for-9 from beyond three-point range vs. Fresno State in the first round of the post-season NIT.

Junior (2005-06): Averaged 11.6 points and 3.1 rebounds. Ranked fourth in the SEC in three-point field goals made (2.4), fifth in three-point field goal percentage (.400), and tenth in steals (1.6 spg). Started 29 of 30 games. Scored 20 or more points five times, registering a season-high 22 points vs. Howard. Recorded 20 points and a season-high five assists vs. Alabama. Hit 5-for-6 from three-point range in scoring 20 points vs. Tennessee. Tallied 17 points, six rebounds, and a career-high-matching five steals vs. Clemson.

Sophomore (2004-05): Averaged 15.2 points (ranked ninth in the SEC) and 3.5 rebounds. Also ranked seventh in the conference in steals (1.8 spg). Started 22 of 23 games, missing five contests due to a sprained ankle. Scored 20 or more points six times. Exploded for a career-high 31 points vs. at Oregon State. Posted 21 points vs. Tennessee and scored 22 points in the rematch. Registered 20 points and a season-high eight rebounds vs. Florida. Tallied 18 points and a career-high five steals vs. Kentucky.

Freshman (2003-04): Averaged 9.5 points and 2.6 rebounds. Started all 30 games. Scored in double figure 13 times. Posted 18 points at Tennessee. Registered season highs of six assists and four steals vs. Towson. Narrowly missed a double-double with 11 points and a career-high nine rebounds vs. Alabama. Tallied 18 points and five rebounds in the regular season finale vs. Vanderbilt. Tied an Tournament record with eight three-pointers made in scoring a season-high 25 points vs. Auburn in the first round of the SEC Tournament.
