College Highlights: Highest-rated member of Tech's 2005 incoming freshman class who developed into a strong perimeter scoring threat before missing the last three months of his sophomore season due to a violation of Institute policy ... Became the 38th player to surpass 1,000 career points on March 12 of his senior year against Clemson ... Finished his career 10th in three-point attempts ... Had 52 career games with double-digit points.

Senior (2008-09): Finished the season as Tech's leading scorer at 15.5 ppg, and also led the Jackets in scoring ... Scored 20 or more points in six of his last seven games, including 30 in his final home game against Miami and a career-high 32 against Clemson in the first round of the ACC Tournament ... Averaged .251 points per game over that stretch, making .453 percent of his field goal tries (62-137), and .432 percent from three-point range (41-95) ... Made the ACC All-Tournament second team after averaging 28.5 points in two games ... Averaged a team-high and a career-high 34.7 minutes.

Junior (2007-08): Started Tech's first 14 games of the season before Tech's Jan. 12 game at Miami ... Was Tech's top offensive performer following team's return from the Paradise Jam, averaging 16.8 points over the next six games ... Had 15 double-digit games on the season, 10 in a row between Nov. 11 and Dec. 27 ... Scored a season-high 22 points each against Georgia State and Kansas ... Looked more to find others for open shots (fifth in the team with 42 assists) ... Had a career-best six assists against Winthrop, three each against four other teams.

Sophomore (2006-07): Tech's top scorer through the first 10 games of the season, reaching double digits in every game and exceeding .500 percent from the floor in all but two ... Scored 20 or more four times (Georgia State, UCLA, Penn State, Miami) ... Suspended from the team for spring semester following a violation of Institute policy, but remained in school ... Shot the ball extremely well (.532 percent overall, .476 percent on threes), carrying over a strong finish in his freshman year ... Shot .767 percent on free throws (23-30) after going just 17-30 as a freshman.

Freshman (2005-06): Honorable mention ACC All-Freshman ... Ranked third among ACC freshmen in scoring average at 8.9 points a game overall ... Started the final eight games of the season, the first starts of his career, and notched double-digit efforts in five of them ... Missed five games in late December/early January with a stress fracture in the fibula of his left leg ... Returned to the court about a week ahead of schedule on Jan. 8 against Boston College ... Reached double digits in 10 games altogether.

Personal: Son of Dorothy Bryant and Earnest Clinch, Sr. ... His aunt, Betty Bryant, played basketball at Alabama ... Majored in Management ... Worked in the Tech Alumni Association office the summer before his freshman year.
