Pro Career Highlights: Played with the Gary Steelheads in the USBL in the summer of 2007, averaging 11.5 points, 3.9 rebounds, and 3.8 assists in 25 games. Split the summer of 2006 between the USBL and the Dominican Republic. In 21 total games with the Pennsylvania Valley Dawgs and the Brooklyn Kings in the USBL, averaged 13.1 points and 5.0 rebounds. With Constituyentes de San Cristobal in the Dominican Republic, averaged 12.4 points, 4.3 rebounds, and 3.6 assists in ten games. Played with the Michigan Mayhem in the CBA in 2005-06, averaging 5.4 points, 2.5 rebounds, and 3.9 assists in 11 games. Played with the Idaho Stampede in the CBA in 2004-05, averaging 7.1 points, 3.4 rebounds, and 3.6 assists in 44 games. In the summer of 2004, played with the Pennsylvania Valley Dawgs in the USBL, averaging 9.7 points and 3.0 rebounds in 23 games. Played with the Fresno Heat Wave in the ABA in 2003-04, averaging 19.5 points, 7.9 rebounds, and 6.8 assists. Spent the summer of 2003 in the Dominican Republic with Duarte Sigue, averaging 20.1 points and 5.0 rebounds. In the summer of 2001, played with San Lazaro and San Francisco in the Dominican Republic, averaging 26.3 points, 7.0 rebounds, and 6.0 assists before moving on to play with the Baltimore Blaze in the NRL, averaging 16 points and five rebounds. Spent the 2000-01 season with the Washington Warriors in the UBA, averaging 33.5 points, seven rebounds, and four assists in two games.

College Highlights: Named NAIA All-American and Player of the Year as a senior at Voorhees, after averaging 25.3 points, 6.2 rebounds, 4.1 assists, and 3.3 steals in 1999-00. Averaged 17.6 points, 5.1 rebounds, 3.2 assists, and 1.9 steals as a junior in 1998-99.
