College Highlights: Played in 124 career games averaging 12.6 points, 7.3 rebounds and 1.9 assists ... seventh on the all-time school scoring chart with 1,581 points for 12.8 career points-per-game average ... set the Georgia Southern record for career games played with 124

Senior (2007-08): Played in 32 games, started in 31 ... First team all-Southern Conference selection by both coaches and media... Scored in double figures 27 times during 2007-08... led the Eagles in scoring 19 times during the season, including 12 consecutive games with the top points... had career best 29 points against Wofford on 2-14-2009... top rebounder in 13 games... pulled down 17 boards against Mercer (11-27-06)... etched his name in Georgia Southern three-point field goal percentage mark with a 4-4 performance in career best Wofford game.

Junior (2006-07): Second Team All-Southern Conference Media... Started all 31 games... Averaged 14.5 points (second on the team) and a team-leading 8.2 rebounds per contest... Shot a team-best .527 percent from the floor and had 46 blocks... Set school record for career blocks at Illinois and finished the season with 153.

Sophomore (2004-05): In 29 starts, averaged 11.4 points (3rd on the team) and 7.4 rebounds (1st) per game... Rebounding average ranked fourth in the Southern Conference... Also ranked in the top five in the league in field goal percentage (5th, 53.7), blocked shots (3rd, 1.9) and defensive rebounds (T-1st, 5.17)... Shot .537 percent from the floor, second on the squad... Posted five double-doubles on the season.

Freshman (2004-05): Played in all 31 games, making 13 starts ... Named to the Southern Conference All-Freshman team ... Blocked 50 shots, the most ever in a single season at Georgia Southern ... Ranked fourth in the conference in blocked shots ... Also set a new freshman class record in rebounds (214) ... Averaged 8.2 points, 6.9 rebounds and 1.6 blocks per game.

Personal: Son of Ola Graham ... Sports hero is Michael Jordan; non-sports hero is his mother... Best athlete he's played against is Luol Deng... People say he looks like Kevin Garnett... Goal in life is to reach the NBA.
