Pro Career Highlights: Participated in NBA summer league with the New York Knicks in the summer of 2004. Played with the Jersey Squires in the ABA during the 2003-04 season (statistics unavailable). Spent the summer of 2003 with the Westchester Wildfire in the USBL, appearing in 25 games and averaging 7.0 points, 2.5 rebounds, and 2.7 assists. Briefly played with the Phoenix Eclipse in the ABA in 2001-02, averaging 5.7 points and 4.7 assists in three games. An early entry candidate for the 2001 NBA Draft, but was not selected.

College Highlights: Named to the Atlantic 10 All-Rookie team as a sophomore. Started 58 of 59 career games.

Junior (2000-01): Averaged 16.9 points, 4.0 rebounds, and 2.6 assists. Posted a season-high 38 points, shooting 17-for-20 from the free throw line, vs. La Salle. Recorded 21 points in the season opener vs. Fairfield. Shot 13-for-16 from the free throw line on his way to 21 points vs. Hartford. Registered a double-double of 25 points and 11 rebounds vs. Xavier. Scored 22 points vs. Massachusetts. Dished out a season-high seven assists at Temple

Sophomore (1999-00): Averaged 15.7 points, 4.0 rebounds, and 3.3 assists. Recorded a season-high 33 points at San Francisco. Tallied 21 points and four assists vs. Murray State. Registered 25 points vs. St. Bonaventure. Posted 20 points and seven rebounds vs. Fordham. Led team with 27 points vs. Xavier in the Atlantic 10 Tournament.

Freshman (1998-99): Sat out the season while working towards NCAA academic eligibility requirements.
