**Pro Career Highlights:** Spent the 2007-08 season in Switzerland with Bennetton Fribourg Olympic. Averaged 11.8 points and 6.9 rebounds in 21 Swiss League games and 8.7 points and 6.6 rebounds in nine ULEB Cup games. Played with TV Lich in the German 2.Bundesliga in 2006-07, averaged 20.0 points and 10.3 rebounds in 29 games. Spent the summer of 2006 with the Houston Blaze in the TPBL (statistics unavailable).

**College Highlights:** Became the first player in school history to lead the team in blocked shots three straight seasons. Started 45 of 111 career games.

**Senior (2004-05):** Averaged 3.6 points and 4.7 rebounds in 19.5 minutes a contest. Started all 35 games. Scored season-high 11 points and grabbed eight rebounds vs. SMU. Tallied a season-high nine rebounds and a career-high four blocked shots vs. Texas Tech.

**Junior (2003-04):** Averaged 2.2 points and 3.5 rebounds in 13.7 minutes a contest. Scored season-high seven points on three separate occasions. Pulled down a career-high ten rebounds vs. Houston.

**Sophomore (2002-03):** Averaged 1.9 points and 2.2 rebounds in 10.5 minutes a contest. Started nine times. Scored career-high 13 points vs. Washington State. Grabbed a season-high nine rebounds at Houston.

**Freshman (2001-02):** Averaged 0.7 points and 1.1 rebounds in 4.6 minutes a contest. Started once. Scored four points vs. Lenoir-Rhyne and Appalachian State. Grabbed four rebounds vs. Houston.
