Sophomore (2001-02): averaged 16.8 points, 2.9 rebounds, and 5.3 assists. Started all 29 games he appeared in. Led team in scoring, assists, and steals. Scored in double figures 28 times, tallying 20 or more points on six occasions. Recorded career-high 34 points in season finale against Iowa on Mar. 2, and was named Big Ten Player of the Week after that performance and a 32 point game against Ohio State on Feb. 26. Scored 21 points and dished out eight assists against Stanford on Dec. 29. Led team with 20 points against Indiana in the quarterfinals of the Big Ten Tournament on Mar. 9. Scored 18 points against North Carolina State in the first round of the NCAA Tournament on Mar. 15. Was named First Team All-Big Ten.

Freshman (2000-01): averaged 7.4 points and 3.6 assists in 22.0 minutes a game. Started nine times for a team that reached the NCAA Final Four. Ranked second on the team in assists, and assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.75 ranked eighth in the Big Ten. Scored in double figures nine times, with a season-high of 16 points against Oakland on Nov. 19. Recorded 15 points and seven assists against Florida on Dec. 6. Tallied 15 points and nine assists at Loyola (IL) on Dec. 9. Scored 11 points against Fresno State in the second round of the NCAA tournament on Mar. 18. Had eight points in the Final Four against Arizona on Mar. 31.
