Pro Career Highlights: Started the 2006-07 season in Lebanon with Antranik Beirut, averaging 17.9 points and 13.9 rebounds in 17 games. Finished the year in Iraq with Al Kahraba Electricity (statistics unavailable).

College Highlights: Finished collegiate career at Purdue after playing first two-and-a-half seasons at Connecticut. Originally planned on sitting out the 2006-07 season with a bad back, but decided instead to turn professional. Was a member of Connecticut's 2004 NCAA Championship team.

Junior (2005-06): Averaged 10.1 points and 4.0 rebounds in 19.2 minutes a contest. Became eligible to play after the first semester and started five times. Scored in double figures 11 times and paced the team in scoring in eight games. Registered career-high 18 points on 7-for-11 shooting at Indiana. Posted 18 points vs. Northwestern and Wisconsin. Tallied 13 points and a season-high seven rebounds at Memphis. Scored 17 points and blocked a season-high three shots vs. Minnesota.

Redshirt Sophomore (2004-05): At Purdue, averaged 3.2 points and 4.6 rebounds in 7.4 minutes a contest, appearing in five games before making the decision to transfer after the first semester.

Sophomore (2003-04): Averaged 2.0 points and 2.3 rebounds in 6.8 minutes a contest, appearing in four games before sitting out the rest of the season due to a bulging disk in his lower back. Recorded four points and three rebounds in his final appearance of the season vs. Georgia Tech.

Freshman (2002-03): Averaged 4.1 points and 5.6 rebounds in 17.0 minutes a contest. Came off the bench in all 23 appearances. Registered four double-figure rebounding games, including a season-high 14 boards vs. Syracuse and Notre Dame. Also matched season-high of nine points vs. Syracuse. Tallied nine points and nine rebounds vs. St. John's. Led team with nine rebounds in the first round of the NCAA Tournament vs. BYU.

Personal: Majored in law and society with a minor in political science.
