Pro Career Highlights: Played with the Chicago Windy City Dawgs in the International Basketball League in the summer of 2005, averaging 25.4 points in ten games. Ranked seventh in the league in scoring. Spent the 2004-05 season with the Akron Wingfoots in the North American Basketball League, averaging 25.6 points, 6.6 rebounds, and 6.3 assists in 25 games. Spent the fall of 2004 with the World Basketball Stars Tour Team which played exhibition games against NCAA opponents. Played with the KMK Hoopers in the summer of 2003, averaging 29.9 points, 7.3 rebounds, and 6.8 assists in 25 games.

College Highlights: Finished collegiate career at DePaul after playing first two seasons at Kansas. Sat out the 2000-01 season at DePaul under NCAA transfer rules.

Senior (2002-03): Averaged 3.4 points, 1.8 rebounds, and 1.8 assists in 19.0 minutes a contest. Started once. Posted season-high ten points at East Carolina. Tallied nine points, six rebounds, and a season-high five assists vs. Charlotte. Tallied seven points vs. Loyola-Chicago. Registered seven points and five rebounds at Southern Miss.

Junior (2001-02): Averaged 4.0 points, 1.7 rebounds, and 1.3 assists in 16.6 minutes a contest. Started nine times in 18 appearances, missing the last six games of the season due to an injured knee. Scored season-high 13 points at St. Louis. Pulled down a season-high six rebounds vs. Fordham. Tallied seven points and a season-high five assists at East Carolina.

Sophomore (1999-00): At Kansas, averaged 3.2 points, 2.4 rebounds, and 1.9 assists in 16.6 minutes a contest. Set season highs of ten points and seven assists vs. Kansas State in the first round of the Big 12 Tournament. Scored nine points at Iowa. Registered eight points in 12 minutes vs. Pennsylvania. Pulled down a season-high seven rebounds at Colorado.

Freshman (1998-99): Averaged 4.1 points, 2.1 rebounds, and 1.6 assists in 14.7 minutes a contest. Scored in double figures three times, posting a season-high 12 points at Baylor. Scored ten points and grabbed a season-high seven rebounds at Missouri. Dished out a season-high six assists at Colorado.
