College Highlights: Finished collegiate career ninth all-time in Rutgers history in assists (305), 12th in free throw percentage (.785), tied for 14th in steals (117), and 33rd in scoring (1,026 points). Started 121 of 124 career games.

Senior (2006-07): Averaged 10.1 points and 2.4 rebounds. Started 28 of 29 games. Scored in double figures 16 times. Posted season highs of 28 points and six rebounds vs. South Carolina State. Registered 16 points vs. Bradley. Led team with 17 points on 6-for-9 shooting at Providence. Scored 12 points at Marquette. Contributed 13 points and three assists vs. Notre Dame.

Junior (2005-06): Averaged 9.5 points, 3.2 rebounds, and 2.7 assists. Started all 33 games. Scored in double figures 19 times. Recorded season-high 17 points in season opener vs. Austin Peay. Posted 16 points at St. Mary's (Calif.). Pulled down a season-high eight rebounds vs. Seton Hall. Tallied 11 points, seven rebounds, and a season-high seven assists vs. Villanova. Scored 15 points vs. South Florida. Matched season high with 17 points vs. Penn State in the first round of the post-season NIT.

Sophomore (2004-05): Averaged 6.4 points, 3.2 rebounds, and 2.9 assists. Started 28 of 29 games. Scored in double figures six times, posting a season-high 16 points at Connecticut. Scored 15 points in the rematch. Pulled down a career-high ten rebounds vs. Wisconsin. Dished out a career-high 11 assists vs. Syracuse. Tallied 11 points, seven rebounds, six assists, and four steals vs. Penn State.

Freshman (2002-03): Averaged 7.2 points, 3.4 rebounds, and 2.9 assists. Started 32 of 33 games. Scored in double figures ten times. Scored 16 points vs. Virginia Tech. Posted ten points and seven assists vs. St. John's. Registered 11 points and a season-high eight rebounds at Syracuse. Recorded season-high 19 points vs. Virginia Tech in the first round of the Big East Tournament.
