Pro Career Highlights: Played with the Oklahoma Storm in the USBL in the summer of 2007, averaging 15.6 points and 3.6 rebounds. Spent the 2006-07 season in Finland with Lappeenranta NMKY, averaging 18.5 points and 7.7 rebounds in 44 games. Played in Denmark with the Skovbakken Bears in 2005-06, averaging 19.9 points and 7.6 rebounds in 20 games. Also participated in four EuroCup games, averaging 15.0 points and 7.3 rebounds. Played with the Gulf Coast Bandits in the WBA during the summer of 2005, averaging 9.1 points and 3.8 rebounds in nine games.

College Highlights: Named Third Team All-Sun Belt Conference as a senior. Finished collegiate career at Middle Tennessee State after playing first two seasons at Neosho County Community College in Kansas. Started 56 of 57 career games at Middle Tennessee State.

Senior (2004-05): Averaged 17.4 points and 7.4 rebounds (ranked fifth in the Sun Belt). Started all 31 games. Posted five double-doubles. Recorded career-high 24 points at Arkansas State. Tallied 19 points and ten rebounds at Florida International. Registered a double-double of 12 points and 13 rebounds vs. Auburn in the San Juan Shootout. Pulled down a career-high 14 rebounds vs. Tennessee Wesleyan.

Junior (2003-04): Averaged 12.3 points and 5.8 rebounds. Started 25 of 26 games played, missing three contests due to a knee injury. Scored in double figures 20 times, including 14 of the last 15 games. Posted season highs of 22 points and 12 rebounds. vs. Western Kentucky in the Sun Belt Tournament.

Sophomore (2002-03): At Neosho County CC, averaged 18.3 points and 9.0 rebounds. Ranked fourth in the Jayhawk Conference in scoring and sixth in rebounding. Also ranked ninth in the league in three-point field goal percentage (.405). Earned Second Team All-Conference honors and finished career as the school's fourth all-time leading scorer with 1,140 points.

Freshman (2001-02): Averaged 17.8 points and 8.9 rebounds. Ranked seventh in the Jayhawk Conference in scoring and seventh in rebounding.
