**Pro Career Highlights:** Split the 2007-08 season in the NBA Developmental League with the Iowa Energy and Anaheim Arsenal, averaging 14.9 points and 4.0 rebounds in 49 total games. Scored 20 or more points 15 times, recording a season-high 41 points vs. Austin as a member of Iowa. Selected by Iowa in the seventh round (98<sup>th</sup> pick overall) of the 2007 NBA Developmental League Draft. Spent the summer of 2007 with the Santa Barbara Breakers in the IBL (statistics unavailable). Played briefly for the Idaho Stampede in the NBA Developmental League in 2006-07, averaging 2.2 points and 1.0 rebounds in five games. Selected by Idaho in the tenth round (112<sup>nd</sup> pick overall) of the 2006 NBA Developmental League draft.

**College Highlights:** Earned Honorable Mention All-Big West honors as a junior. Finished collegiate career at Cal State Northridge after playing first two seasons at UC Irvine. Briefly enrolled at NAIA Azusa Pacific before spending the 2004-05 season as a non-basketball playing student at Orange Coast College in Costa Mesa, Calif. An early entry candidate for the 2006 NBA Draft, but was not selected.

**Junior (2005-06):** Averaged a team-leading 17.1 points (ranked 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Big West). Also ranked third in the league in free throw shooting (.824) and tenth in steals (1.18 spg). Scored 20 or more points nine times, and topped the 30-point mark three times. Exploded for a career-high 39 points on 12-for-18 shooting, including 8-for-11 from beyond three-point range, vs. Cal State Fullerton, setting a school single game Division I record. Recorded 36 points, six rebounds, and seven steals vs. Tulsa. Scored 33 points and dished out a season-high five assists vs. Hope International. Tallied 27 points and five rebounds vs. Illinois State. Registered 20 points and seven rebounds at Southern Cal in the season opener. Notched 22 points and seven rebounds vs. UC-Davis.

**Sophomore (2003-04):** At UC Irvine, averaged 11.1 points and 2.6 rebounds. Ranked fourth in the Big West in three-point field goal percentage (.412). Led the team in free throw shooting (.792) while ranking second in scoring and three-point field goals made (40). Started 21 of 24 games before being suspended indefinitely from the team in late February. Registered season-high 37 points, including seven made three-point shots, vs. Arkansas-Monticello in the McCaffrey Classic. Led team with 23 points vs. UC Santa Barbara.

**Freshman (2002-03):** Averaged 5.0 points and 1.5 rebounds in 10.8 minutes a contest. Started six times. Scored in double figures four times, with a season-high 17 points at St. Mary's in his first career start. Tallied 14 points vs. Florida Atlantic. Scored eight points in ten minutes vs. Cal State Northridge in the Big West Tournament quarterfinals.
