Pro Career Highlights: Spent the 2007-08 season in Austria with the Kapfenberg Bulls, averaging 13.5 points, 2.7 rebounds, and 2.0 assists. Played with the Utah Eagles in the CBA in 2006-07, averaging 11.1 points in 22 games. Spent the 2005-06 season with Saint-Etienne in the French ProB league, averaging 7.6 points, 1.5 rebounds, and 1.2 steals in 14 games.

College Highlights: Earned Third Team All-Mountain West Conference honors as a junior and senior. Named league Defensive Player of the Year his junior season. Finished collegiate career at BYU after playing one season each at Pepperdine and Dixie State College in Utah. Spent the 2001-02 season at Utah Valley State but did not play.

Senior (2004-05): Averaged 13.9 points, 3.5 rebounds, and 2.0 assists. Started all 30 games. Scored 20 or more points five times. Recorded career-high 24 points at San Diego State. Tallied 21 points, a season-high nine rebounds, and five assists vs. Boise State. Sank five threes in scoring 22 points and grabbing six rebounds vs. UNLV. Led team with 23 points vs. Cal.

Junior (2003-04): Averaged 12.8 points, 3.5 rebounds, and 1.8 assists. Started 28 of 30 games. Scored 20 or more points four times. Registered season-high 22 points vs. Weber State. Posted 21 points in games at New Mexico and vs. Utah. Recorded 17 points on 6-for-9 shooting and dished out four assists vs. Syracuse in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Sophomore (2002-03): At Dixie State, averaged a team-high 15.5 points (ranked ninth in the SWAC), 5.1 rebounds, 2.3 assists, and 1.8 steals. Scored 20 or more points ten times. Posted season-high 28 points on 11-for-16 shooting vs. Indian Hills CC. Scored a team-high 20 points vs. Georgia Perimeter in the third place game of the NJCAA National Tournament.

Freshman (2000-01): At Pepperdine, averaged 1.8 points and 0.9 rebounds in 4.7 minutes a contest.
