Anaheim Arsenal, waived in November ... in January joined Albuquerque Thunderbirds: 6 games: 7.5 ppg, 2.5 rpg ... in March signed with Colorado 14ers : 4 games: 4.8 ppg, 2.8 rpg, 1.5 apg ... 2007-08: October: Colorado 14ers training camp ... Entente Orleans 45 (France-ProA, starting five), only pre-season, then signed with Colorado 14ers: 12 games: 9.3ppg, 4.3rpg, 1.2apg, in January waived due to injury, later that month signed at Anaheim Arsenal: 28 games: 15.9 ppg, 4.6 rpg, 1.8 apg, 1.2 spg ... 2008-09: Generali Okapi Aalstar (Belgium-D1, starting five): 34 games: 10.6ppg, 4.0rpg, 1.6apg, 1.3spg.

College Highlights: An athletic player who can play either the shooting guard or small forward position...A slasher who can get to the basket and score...Possesses good rebounding skills...Helped the Wolf Pack to two regular season Western Athletic championships, the 2006 WAC Tournament title and back-to-back NCAA appearances in his two seasons on the court.

Senior (2005-06): Was a 2006 WAC All-Defensive Team selection...Also named to the WAC All-Tournament Team...Won the team's Sixth Man Award at the season-end banquet...Played in all 33 games with 19 starts...Started the first 18 games of the season...Scored in double figures in 18 of 33 games and reached double figures for rebounding four times...Finished third on the team with 10.2 points per game...Ranked second on the team and 14th in the WAC with 5.3 rebounds per game...Turned in four double-doubles this season, including 13 points and a career-best 14 rebounds in a Nov. 23 victory at Vermont...Scored a career-high 22 points in Nevada's Dec. 3 win at Pacific... Ranked third on the team and sixth in the WAC in free throw shooting at 77.1 percent (84-109).

Junior (2004-05): Named to the Western Athletic Conference All-Newcomer Team...Played in all 32 games with 11 starts...Ranked third on the team in scoring at 9.4 points per game...Also ranked third on the team in assists at 2.1 per game...Made 20 three-point field-goals, which ranked second on the team behind Nick Fazekas ...Scored a then career-high 19 points on two occasions (vs. San Jose State on 12/30/04 and vs. UTEP on 1/12/05)...Grabbed a then career-high 10 rebounds Dec. 30 vs. San Jose State for his first career double-double...Reached double-figure scoring in 14 games, including eight of the final 12 games of the season...Averaged 11.8 points per game over the final 12 games of the season... Averaged 12.0 points per game in the 2005 NCAA Tournament, which was second on the team to Kevinn Pinkney...Averaged 3.5 rebounds per game...

Diablo Valley College (2002-04): Attended Diablo Valley College in Concord, Calif., for two years...Named allstate both years...Earned Bay Valley Conference MVP honors and was named to the all-conference team...His jersey number was retired following his sophomore season in 2003-04...Played in 30 games and averaged 18.1 points, 7.4 rebounds per game and shot 80 percent from the free throw line.
