NBA Career Highlights: Averaging 2.6 ppg (.390 FG, .216 three-point, .645 FT), 1.6 rpg, 1.2 apg, 0.80 spg, and 12.3 mpg in 121 games over two NBA seasons with Boston (2005-06) and Indiana (2006-07) ... Played in 80 contests (started five) for Boston as a rookie in 2005-06, averaging 3.2 ppg (.395 FG, .225 three-point, .662 FT), 1.8 rpg, 1.6 apg, 1.00 spg, and 15.4 mpg ... Collected 77 steals, fourth-best among rookies ... Finished the season by averaging 2.67 spg over the final six games (ranked fourth on the Celtics with 129 assists, pacing the team in assists on two occasions) ... Dished out a career-high six assists twice (1/7/06 at Washington and 1/21/06 at New Jersey) ... Scored in double-figures for the first time as a pro with 10 points (3-8 FG, 4-4 FT) vs. Portland (2/10/06) ... Hauled in a career-best eight rebounds at Chicago (4/1/06) ... Scored a career-high 14 points (5-7 FG, 2-2 3pt, 2-2 FT) with two rebounds, two assists, two steals, and one block in 26 minutes vs. Cleveland (4/17/06), and encored 48 hours later in the final game of the season with 14 points (5-9 FG, 1-3 3pt, 3-6 FT), one rebound, a career-high five steals, and one block in 30 minutes vs. Miami (4/19/06) ... Has scored in double-figures in four career games.

College Highlights: Named the Sun Belt Conference Defensive Player of the Year in 2004-05 after leading the league with 68 steals in 2004-05 as a senior at Louisiana-Lafayette ... Earned All-Sun Belt Second Team honors after averaging 11.7 ppg (.388 FG%, .321 3pt%, .756 FT%), 4.7 rpg, a team-leading 4.1 apg, and 2.70 spg in 24 games ... Boasted a team-best assist-to-turnover ratio (1.22) and was second in free throw percentage ... Appeared in 18 games as a junior (2003-04), averaging 10.4 ppg (.452 FG%, .361 3pt%, .688 FT%), 4.6 rpg, 3.0 apg, and a teamleading 2.20 spg ... Scored a career-high 28 points to lead the Ragin' Cajuns to a 79-73 win over South Alabama (2/12/04) ... Played first two seasons of collegiate ball at Florida before transferring to LLU, averaging 4.3 ppg (.402 FG%, .280 3pt%, .737 FT%), 2.6 rpg, 2.8 apg, and 1.90 spg in 62 games during freshman and sophomore campaigns with the Gators (2000-01 – 2001-02) ... Sat out the 2002-03 season in complying with NCAA transfer rules.
