Pro Career Highlights: Participated in NBA training camp with the Golden State Warriors in the fall of 2006. Spent the 2005-06 season in the NBA with the Utah Jazz, appearing in 23 games (with two starts) and averaging 3.0 points and 0.9 rebound in 9.1 minutes a contest. Posted season-high 15 points at Toronto.

College Highlights: Named Second Team All-Conference USA as a senior. Ranks as Houston's all-time leader in three-point field goals made (227). Also ranks 13th in scoring with 1,407 career points. Finished collegiate career at Houston after playing freshman season at Indiana. Sat out the 2001-02 season at Houston under NCAA transfer rules.

Senior (2004-05): Led team in scoring (18.3 ppg) and ranked second in rebounding (4.8 rpg) and assists (2.1 apg). Started 30 of 32 games. Scored 20 or more points 15 times. Recorded a double-double of 21 points and ten rebounds at Lamar. Registered 26 points and eight rebounds vs. McNeese State. Tallied 26 points, seven rebounds, and five assists vs. St. Louis. Posted 27 points at Marquette. Scored 26 points and grabbed five rebounds at Cincinnati. Led team with 27 points vs. Louisville. Scored season-high 33 points at Wichita State in the first round of the post-season NIT

Junior (2003-04): Averaged a team-high 16.0 points, 5.4 rebounds, and 3.0 assists. Started all 27 games. Scored 20 or more points ten times. Exploded for a career-high 41 points and grabbed seven rebounds vs. Texas A&M. Registered 25 points vs. Rice. Tallied 22 points, six rebounds, and five assists vs. Washington. Scored 23 points and dished out eight assists at Tulane. Recorded 18 points and six rebounds vs. Cincinnati.

Sophomore (2002-03): Averaged 13.9 points, 5.1 rebounds, and 3.2 assists. Started all 28 games. Scored in double figures 18 times, and posted 20 or more points in nine games. Led team in scoring on ten occasions. Registered season-high 28 points vs. St. Louis. Tallied 25 points and a season-high seven assists vs. Prairie View A&M in his Houston debut. Recorded 23 points vs. TCU. Posted 22 points vs. Memphis and TCU.

Freshman (2000-01): At Indiana, averaged 4.7 points and 1.4 rebounds in 14.1 minutes a contest. Appeared in 30 games, starting four times. Recorded season-high 22 points on 7-for-9 shooting, 5-for-6 from three-point range, vs. Western Michigan. Tallied 20 points and a season-high three assists vs. Northwestern. Registered 16 points and a season-high four rebounds vs. Temple.
