Senior (2006-07): Averaged 1.6 points and 1.3 rebounds in 8.6 minutes a contest. Started four times. Set a career high with nine points and matched a career high with six rebounds at Notre Dame. Tallied a career-high four assists, two rebounds, and two blocked shots vs. Seton Hall. Registered four points, three rebounds, and a block vs. St. John's.

Junior (2005-06): Averaged 1.9 points and 1.5 rebounds in 7.9 minutes a contest. Started once. Scored four or more points in five games. Posted season-high seven points vs. Prairie View A&M. Registered four points, four rebounds, and two assists vs. Chicago State. Tallied five points, five rebounds, and one block vs. Tennessee-Martin in the season opener.

Sophomore (2004-05): Averaged 1.9 points and 1.3 rebounds in 7.8 minutes a contest. Started four times. Recorded season-high eight points vs. Tennessee State. Tallied a career-high six rebounds and four points vs. North Carolina A&T. Scored six points and grabbed four rebounds in a start vs. Morehead State.

Freshman (2003-04): Averaged 0.2 points and 0.6 rebounds in 2.5 minutes a contest. Tallied two points, two assists, and one point vs. VMI. Pulled down a season-high three rebounds at USF. Scored his lone field goal of the season vs. UAB.
