Pro Career Highlights: Spent the 2007-08 season in the NBA Development League with the Albuquerque Thunderbirds, averaging 6.4 points and 4.8 rebounds. Led team in blocked shots with 41. Started 17 of 50 games. Selected by Thunderbirds in ninth round (115th pick overall) of 2007 NBA Developmental League Draft.

College Highlights: Named Second Team All-Conference USA as a senior. Started 69 of 100 career games.

Senior (2005-06): Averaged 12.1 points, a team-high 6.1 rebounds, 1.1 blocked shots, and 1.8 steals. Started 27 of 31 games. Posted five double-doubles. Registered career-high 25 points and pulled down nine rebounds vs. SMU. Tallied 23 points and eight rebounds at North Texas. Scored 17 points and grabbed a career-high 18 rebounds at East Carolina. Posted 12 points, 12 rebounds, and a career-high six blocked shots vs. Marshall. Recorded 16 points and five rebounds at Missouri State in the second round of the post-season NIT.

Junior (2004-05): Averaged 9.8 points, 5.8 rebounds, 1.6 blocked shots (ranked sixth in C-USA), and 2.0 steals (sixth). Started 31 of 32 games. Scored in double figures 14 times. Tallied career-high 19 points and season-high 11 rebounds vs. Memphis. Posted a 11-point, ten-rebound double-double vs. McNeese State. Scored 14 points vs. Washington. Recorded ten points vs. South Florida in the C-USA Tournament. Registered 14 points at Wichita State in the first round of the post-season NIT.

Sophomore (2003-04): Averaged 3.1 points and 4.2 rebounds in 18.0 minutes a contest. Started 11 times. Registered season-high nine points at St. Louis. Grabbed a season-high 16 rebounds vs. Centenary. Pulled down nine boards vs. Texas A&M.

Freshman (2002-03): Averaged 2.5 points and 2.3 rebounds in 8.0 minutes a contest. Posted season-high ten points and grabbed five rebounds vs. Louisiana-Lafayette. Tallied seven points, seven rebounds, and two steals at Texas Tech.
