Pro Career Highlights: Spent the summer of 2008 in the WCBPL with the Santa Barbara Breakers, averaging 14.0 points and 9.4 rebounds in 16 games. Spent the 2007-08 season in the ABA with the Orange County Gladiators (statistics unavailable). Participated in NBA training camp with the Sacramento Kings in the fall of 2007. Played with the Santa Barbara Breakers in the IBL in the summer of 2007 (statistics unavailable). Spent the 2006-07 season in China with the Shanxi Dongshen Kylins and the Henan RenHe Dragons (statistics unavailable). Played with the Tacoma Thunder and the Seattle Mountaineers in the IBL in the summer of 2006 (statistics unavailable). Spent the 2005-06 season with the Tacoma Navigators and Buffalo Rapids in the ABA (statistics unavailable). Participated in NBA summer league with the Seattle SuperSonics in 2005. Started the 2004-05 season with the Fresno Heat Wave in the ABA, averaging 8.3 points and 4.3 rebounds in three games. Finished the year with Dukagjijn Peje in Kosovo (statistics unavailable). Split the 2003-04 season between the Tijuana Tzmania Diablos and the Trenton Jersey Squires in the ABA (statistics unavailable). Played in the USBL in the summer of 2003 with the Pennsylvania Valley Dawgs. Appeared in two games and did not score. Selected by the Huntsville Flight in the seventh round (#33 pick overall) of the 2002 NBDL Draft. Participated in the NBA summer league with the Detroit Pistons and Denver Nuggets in 2002. Signed with the Harlem Globetrotters in the fall of 2002. An early candidate for the 2002 NBA Draft, but was not selected. Also originally declared for the 2001 NBA Draft, but withdrew his name from consideration before the draft. Has also been a member of the And1 Streetball Tour.

College Highlights: Played part of one season at Eastern Oklahoma State Junior College in Wilburton, OK.

Freshman (2000-01): Averaged 2.2 points and 2.3 rebounds in limited action. Shot .667 from the field on 18-for-27 shooting. Became eligible to play the second semester of the season, after obtaining his GED in the fall. Withdrew from school after the season to pursue a professional career.

High School: Was considered a Top 250 recruit in high school at both Freeport HS in Long Island, NY and Winchendon Prep School in Massachusetts.
