Pro Career Highlights: Spent the summer of 2006 with the Dodge City Legend in the USBL, averaging 17.9 points in 32 games. Played the 2005-06 season with the Sioux Falls Skyforce and Gary Steelheads in the CBA. Played with the Legend in the USBL in the summer of 2005, averaging 16.1 points and 4.4 rebounds in 29 games. Spent the 2004-05 season in the CBA with the Gary Steelheads, averaging 7.2 points and 3.4 rebounds in 36 games.

College Highlights: Earned WAC All-Newcomer Team honors as a junior. Finished collegiate career at Fresno State after playing first two seasons at South Plains College in Levelland, Texas.

Senior (2003-04): Averaged 10.7 points and 3.5 rebounds in 13 games before being suspended from the team for violating team rules. Started seven times. Recorded season-high 20 points vs. Princeton. Registered 17 points and six rebounds vs. Southern Cal. Posted 13 points and seven rebounds at Oregon. Narrowly missed a double-double with 15 points and a team-high nine rebounds vs. Creighton.

Junior (2002-03): Averaged 10.0 points and 4.5 rebounds in 23.8 minutes a contest. Started six times. Recorded a career-high 22 points and grabbed seven rebounds at Tulsa. Led team with 18 points at Boise State. Posted first career double-double with ten points and a career-high 11 rebounds vs. Sacramento State. Registered 17 points at SMU.

Sophomore (2001-02): At South Plains, averaged 15.7 points and 4.7 rebounds. Started 34 games for a team that went 30-5 and advanced to the NJCAA National Tournament. Scored a season-high 34 points vs. New Mexico Military Academy.

Freshman (2000-01): Averaged 11.1 points and 3.7 rebounds. Ranked third on the team in scoring and free throw percentage.
