Pro Career Highlights: Has played in various minor leagues domestically as well as overseas. Played briefly with the Gary Steelheads in the USBL in the summer of 2007, appearing in two games and averaging 22.5 points. Played with the Utah Eagles and Yakima Sun Kings in the CBA in 2006-07, averaging 20.7 points and 3.4 rebounds in 42 total games. Ranked third in the league in scoring and free throw percentage. Appeared in five games with the Kansas Cagerz in the USBL in the summer of 2006, averaging 7.6 points and 7.6 rebounds in five games. Spent the 2005-06 season in the CBA with the Gary Steelheads, averaging 9.5 points and 2.9 rebounds in 48 games. Played with the Detroit Pros in the IBL in the summer of 2005, averaging 19.1 points. Spent the 2004-05 season overseas with the Pertemps Birmingham Bullets in England, averaging 17.6 points and 4.7 rebounds in 23 games. Played with the Harlem Globetrotters in 2003. Selected by the Greenville Groove in the 11th round (83rd pick overall) of the 2001 NBA Developmental League Draft. An early entry candidate for the 2001 NBA Draft, but was not selected.

College Highlights: Played one season at Iowa after spending first two years at Southeastern Community College in West Burlington, Iowa. Enrolled at Kentucky Wesleyan in the spring of 2001, but was not eligible to play.

Junior (1999-00): Ranked second on the team in scoring (12.2 ppg) and added 3.6 rpg. Started 19 of 30 games. Exploded for career-high 36 points on 11-for-16 shooting, 5-for-7 from three-point range vs. Penn State. Tallied 29 points, seven rebounds, and five steals at Minnesota. Posted 22 points and six rebounds vs. Northwestern. Scored 20 points, dished out five assists, and blocked two shots vs. Michigan. Tallied 20 points at Illinois. Registered 18 points and a career-high 15 rebounds at Indiana.

Sophomore (1998-99): At Southeastern CC, ranked eighth nationally in scoring (22.2 ppg) while also averaging 5.8 rebounds, 2.8 assists, and 2.3 steals. Registered season-high 38 points vs. Belleville Area CC. Named team MVP and earned Second Team NJCAA All-American honors.

Freshman (1997-98): Averaged 19.8 points, 9.3 rebounds, and 2.5 assists. Named team MVP.
