College Highlights: Named First Team All-Conference USA his junior and senior seasons. Ranks as Houston's 14th all-time leading scorer with 1,435 career points, which is also the top mark for a two-year player. Finished collegiate career at Houston after starting at Providence and routing through San Jacinto College in Pasadena, Texas.

Senior (2007-08): Ranked second in C-USA and finished eighth nationally in scoring (23.6 ppg). Also led the league and ranked 14th nationally in free throw percentage (.884) and second in the league and fourth nationally in three-point field goals made per game (4.26). Started 33 of 34 games. Scored 20 or more points 20 times and topped the 30-point mark nine times. Exploded for a career-high 52 points including seven made threes vs. Southern Miss. Registered 41 points, six rebounds, and seven assists at UAB. Sank 9-for-14 from beyond the three-point line in scoring 32 points vs. Middle Tennessee State. Recorded nine made threes on his way to 37 points at College of Charleston. Tallied 33 points and five rebounds vs. Tulsa. Scored 29 points and grabbed a season-high eight rebounds at East Carolina. Led team with 24 points vs. UTEP in the quarterfinals of the C-USA Tournament. Scored 33 points vs. Valparaiso in the quarterfinals of the post-season College Basketball Invitational.

Junior (2006-07): Led team and ranked second in C-USA in scoring (19.2 ppg). Also led the league in three-point field goals made per game (3.5) and ranked 11th in assists (3.4 apg). Started 32 of 33 games. Scored 20 or more points 16 times and topped the 30-point mark four times. Recorded season-high 36 points vs. Central Florida. Tallied 32 points at Memphis. Sank seven threes in scoring 33 points in the season opener at Rhode Island. Scored 19 points and dished out a career-high eight assists vs. South Alabama. Hit a school-record nine threes in a 33-point performance vs. Prairie View A&M.

Sophomore (2005-06): At San Jacinto, averaged a team-high 18.4 points, 4.3 rebounds, and 3.1 assists. Registered season-high 33 points vs. Panola. Earned First Team All-Region XIV honors and was named Region XIV Tournament MVP. Helped lead San Jacinto to a 24-12 overall record and an appearance in the NJCAA National Tournament.

Freshman (2004-05): At Providence, averaged 1.8 points and 0.4 rebounds in 6.5 minutes a contest. Scored season-high 11 points vs. Syracuse. Tallied seven points and four rebounds vs. Maine.

Personal: Majored in sociology. Nickname is "Fluff". Enjoys playing tennis. Favorite NBA team is the Philadelphia 76ers. Also attended Hill House High School in New Haven, Conn.
