2008-09 Oklahoma City: Appeared in 26 games ... averaged

2007-08 Seattle: Appeared in eight games...Grabbed five rebounds twice...Missed 70 total games...Sat out 41 games due to right knee tendonitis and the final 29 games of the season after suffering a torn meniscus in his right knee at Portland on 2/21... Surgery performed on 3/4.

2006-07 Seattle: Missed entire season after suffering a torn anterior cruciate ligament (ACL) in his right knee in a preseason game vs. Sacramento on 10/25...Surgery performed on 11/22.

2005-06 Seattle: Averaged 6.4 ppg, 5.7 rpg and 1.2 bpg in 21.0 mpg...Appeared in 47 games (20 starts)...Scored 10-plus points nine times...Led or co-led team in rebounding 12 times...Shot 51.5 percent (124-241) from the field...Sat out the final three games of the season with a sprained right foot...Scored a career-high 17 points and blocked a career-high four shots at Denver on 3/24...Had successful surgery on his broken nose on 2/22 and missed four games due to the injury...Recorded a career-high 13 rebounds vs. Atlanta on 2/10...Notched his first career double-double with 14 points and 12 rebounds vs. New Jersey on 1/28.

2004-05 Seattle: Averaged 0.9 ppg, 0.3 rpg and 4.5 mpg in 16 games...Placed on the Injured List on 4/8 with right knee patellar tendonitis and missed six games...Placed on the Injured List on 12/11 with a sprained right thumb and missed 25 games.
