Pro Career Highlights: Participated in NBA summer league with the Sacramento Kings in the summer of 2006.

College Highlights: Emerged as one of the nation's most improved players as a junior, before injuries limited him during his senior season. Started 27 of 86 career games.

Senior (2005-06): Averaged 4.9 points and 3.0 rebounds in 16.4 minutes a contest. Missed 11 games due to a stress fracture in his left heel and a torn meniscus in his right knee. Scored a season-high 14 points and grabbed six rebounds vs. Long Beach State. Pulled down a season-high seven rebounds vs. DePaul. Tallied eight points, three rebounds, and two assists at UCLA. Posted ten points and five rebounds at Stanford. Recorded 13 points vs. North Carolina State in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Junior (2004-05): Averaged 13.3 points and 6.3 rebounds. Ranked seventh in the Pac-10 in field goal percentage (.543). Started 26 of 29 games. Scored in double figures 21 times and posted six double-doubles. Scored a career-high 25 points and grabbed ten rebounds for his first career double-double vs. Colorado. Posted 24 points vs. Stanford. Tallied 22 points and eight rebounds vs. UNLV. Recorded 14 points and a career-high 14 rebounds at UCLA. Scored 22 points and pulled down ten rebounds vs. Oregon State.

Sophomore (2003-04): Averaged 2.6 points and 1.7 rebounds in 8.5 minutes a contest. Registered season-high 11 points on 5-for-5 shooting and grabbed five rebounds at Arizona. Tallied eight points, a season-high six rebounds, and a career-high four blocked shots vs. Oregon. Scored seven points and grabbed three rebounds at Washington.

Freshman (2002-03): Averaged 0.8 points and 0.8 rebounds in 3.4 minutes a contest. Grabbed a season-high three rebounds vs. Grambling. Posted season-high seven points in four minutes of playing time vs. Oregon State in the semifinals of the Pac-10 Tournament.
