Pro Career Highlights: Played with Geoplin Slovan in both the Adriatic League and the Slovenian League in 2005-06. In the Adriatic League, appeared in 23 games and averaged 7.1 points and 2.6 rebounds. In the Slovenian League, appeared in 36 games and averaged 9.8 points and 4.1 rebounds.

College Highlights: Named Conference USA Sixth Person of the Year as a senior. Finished collegiate career at UAB after playing first two seasons at Okaloosa-Walton Community College in Niceville, Florida.

Senior (2004-05): Averaged 11.0 points and 3.6 rebounds in 18.8 minutes a contest. Started ten of 26 games, missing seven games due to a broken bone in his left foot. Scored season-high 19 points vs. South Florida. Posted 18 points in back-to-back games vs. Murray State and Southern Miss. Registered 18 points, five rebounds, and three steals vs. Oral Roberts. Tallied 13 points at Clemson. Recorded 17 points and five rebounds at South Florida. Scored 13 points and grabbed a season-high seven rebounds vs. Belmont. Contributed nine points and six rebounds vs. LSU in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Junior (2003-04): Averaged 9.2 points and 3.0 rebounds in 18.0 minutes a contest. Led team and ranked sixth in Conference USA in field goal percentage (.507). Scored in double figures 16 times, with a season-high 22 points to go with a season-high seven rebounds vs. LSU. Recorded 15 points and four rebounds in the season opener vs. Georgia Southern. Scored 12 points in 13 minutes vs. Washington. Tallied 11 points, seven rebounds, and four assists vs. South Alabama. Dished out a career-high seven assists vs. Kentucky in the second round of the NCAA Tournament vs. Kentucky.

Sophomore (2002-03): At Okaloosa-Walton CC, averaged 19.7 points and a team-high 8.0 rebounds. Also led the team in steals (2.2 spg). Helped lead the team to a 31-4 record and a sixth-place finish in the NJCAA Tournament.

Personal: Twin brother, Donell, is a forward with the Washington Wizards.
