College Highlights: Earned Big 12 All-Defensive Team honors his sophomore, junior, and senior seasons. Helped Kansas to four straight Big 12 regular season titles and the 2008 national championship. Started 108 of 134 career games.

Senior (2007-08): Averaged 7.3 points, 4.1 assists (ranked third in the Big 12), and 2.0 steals (third). Started all 40 games. Scored in double figures 11 times. Recorded a season-high 22 points, including 14-for-15 free throws vs. Baylor. Registered 17 points at Georgia Tech. Hit all five shots in scoring 15 points vs. Texas Tech. Dished out a career-high 11 assists vs. Ohio. Pulled down a career-high ten rebounds at Iowa State. Grabbed a career-high eight steals vs. Yale. Scored 13 points vs. UNLV in the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Notched 15 points and five assists vs. Villanova in the Sweet Sixteen. Contributed seven points and four assists vs. North Carolina in the Final Four.

Junior (2006-07): Averaged 7.2 points, 4.4 assists (sixth in the Big 12), and 2.0 steals (third). Started 36 of 37 games. Scored in double figures seven times. Recorded a season-high 17 points vs. Texas. Earned Las Vegas Invitational All-Tournament honors after scoring ten points vs. Ball State and tallying 12 points and seven rebounds vs. Florida. Registered 14 points and six assists at Colorado. Posted 16 points, eight assists, and five steals vs. Niagara in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. Scored 11 points and grabbed five steals vs. UCLA in the Regional Finals.

Sophomore (2005-06): Averaged 9.3 points, 4.6 assists (fourth), and 2.3 steals (third). Also ranked eighth in the league in free throw shooting (.742). Started 32 of 33 games. Scored in double figures 13 times. Posted a career-high 24 points, shooting 12-for-13 from the free throw line at Texas A&M. Tallied 12 points, a season-high eight rebounds, and seven assists at Missouri. Dished out a season-high nine assists vs. Baylor. Registered 18 points at Iowa State. Recorded 18 points and seven assists vs. Bradley in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Freshman (2004-05): Averaged 3.5 points and 1.0 assists in 10.1 minutes a contest. Scored in double figures three times. Recorded season-high 13 points vs. Nevada. Notched 12 points vs. Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Registered ten points and season-highs with three rebounds and five assists vs. St. Joseph's.
