Pro Career Highlights: Spent the majority of the 2007-08 season in the PBL with the Rochester RazorSharks, averaging 15.7 points and 5.4 rebounds in 20 games. Signed with the Austin Toros in the NBA Developmental League at the end of the regular season for the playoffs but did not appear in any games. Selected by the Sioux Falls Skyforce in the ninth round (118th pick overall) of the 2007 NBA D-League Draft.

College Highlights: Played one season at Newberry after spending first two years at Clinton Junior College in South Carolina and Tallahassee Community College in Florida. Attended Newberry during the 2006-07 season but did not play basketball.

Junior (2005-06): Led the team in rebounding (6.5 rpg) and blocked shots (1.0 bpg) while ranking second in scoring (14.2 ppg). Scored 20 or more points six times and posted four double-doubles. Set career high with 24 points at Wingate. Matched career high with 24 points and added 12 rebounds and five steals in the rematch. Recorded a 22-point, career-high 14-rebound double-double vs. Mars Hill. Tallied 16 points, ten rebounds, and a career-high six steals vs. North Greenville. Scored 12 points at Charleston Southern. Posted career-high of four blocked shots twice, vs. Tusculum and at Mars Hill.

Sophomore (2004-05): At Tallahassee CC, averaged 8.3 points and 3.4 rebounds in 14.4 minutes a contest. Appeared in seven games.

Freshman (2003-04): At Clinton JC, averaged 17 points. Earned Second Team Region X honors. Helped Clinton to a 22-10 record and a conference championship.
