Pro Career Highlights: Spent the summer of 2006 with Grises de Humacao in Puerto Rico, averaging 16.4 points and 5.1 rebounds in 24 games. Played with the Tulsa 66ers in the NBA Developmental League in 2005-06, averaging 12.7 points and 3.3 rebounds in 12 games. Also spent time on the roster of the New Orleans/Oklahoma City Hornets, but remained on the inactive list.

College Highlights: Earned First Team All-Conference USA honors as a freshman. Named Conference USA Freshman of the Year and National Freshman of the Year by ESPN.com.

Sophomore (2004-05): Averaged 14.5 points and 5.8 rebounds. Appeared in 16 games, starting ten, before being declared academically ineligible for the rest of the season in January. Posted career-high 31 points vs. Arkansas State. Tallied 20 points and 11 rebounds vs. George Mason. Posted 18 points and a career-high three steals vs. Pittsburgh. Scored 17 points and grabbed eight offensive rebounds vs. Providence.

Freshman (2003-04): Led team in scoring (17.4 ppg) and rebounding (6.5 rpg). Scored in double figures 26 times and scored 20 or more points 12 times. Registered a season-high 29 points vs. Charlotte. Posted 26 points and 13 rebounds vs. TCU. Shot 6-for-7 from three-point range on his way to 28 points vs. Marquette. Pulled down a season-high 14 rebounds in his collegiate debut vs. Wake Forest. Had a streak of 30 consecutive free throws made.
