College Highlights: Started 83 of 103 career games. Posted four 20-point games and ten double-doubles over his four-year career. Redshirted the 2002-03 season while recovering from microfracture surgery to repair cartilage damage and bone chips behind the right patella (kneecap).

Senior (2006-07): Averaged 6.8 points and 6.3 rebounds in 25.0 minutes a contest. Started 18 of 30 games. Scored in double figures eight times. Registered four double-doubles. Matched career high with 23 points at Xavier. Posted 14 points and 12 rebounds vs. Iowa. Scored 12 points and grabbed a season-high 13 rebounds vs. Northern Colorado. Recorded 17 points and 12 rebounds vs. Davidson. Tallied 14 points and 11 rebounds vs. Arizona. Pulled down a team-high 12 rebounds vs. Oregon State.

Junior (2005-06): Averaged 7.3 points and 5.1 rebounds. Started all 26 games. Scored in double figures seven times. Recorded career-high 23 points on 10-for-15 shooting vs. UCLA. Narrowly missed a double-double with 11 points and nine rebounds in the rematch. Tallied 19 points and seven rebounds vs. USC and posted a 11-point, ten-rebound double-double in the rematch. Grabbed a career-high 16 rebounds vs. Washington State.

Sophomore (2004-05): Averaged 8.1 points and 6.5 rebounds. Started all 32 games. Scored in double figures 13 times. Posted five double-doubles. Recorded a season-high 20 points on 8-for-12 shooting vs. USC. Matched season high with 20 points and grabbed ten rebounds at Oregon. Hit all seven field goal attempts on his way to posting an 18-point, ten-rebound double-double vs. Washington State. Scored 13 points and grabbed a season-high 14 rebounds at Temple. Registered a career-high four blocked shots vs. Long Island. Tallied 15 points and eight rebounds vs. California.

Freshman (2003-04): Averaged 3.8 points and 2.6 rebounds in 15.9 minutes a contest. Missed the first ten games of the season while recovering from knee surgery. Started seven times. Scored in double figures twice, recording ten points vs. Oregon and a season-high 12 points in the rematch. Grabbed a season-high six rebounds vs. California. Tallied five points and five rebounds in his collegiate debut vs. Stanford.

Personal: Graduated with a bachelor's degree in Spanish in May of 2006. Is fluent in five languages – English, Spanish, French, Eton, and Bulu. Also practices Karate and Tae Kwon Do.
