**Pro Career Highlights:** Averaged 9.7 points and 4.5 assists in 46 games (nine starts) with the Sioux Falls Skyforce during the 2004-05 season...averaged 18.9 points and 6.4 assists in the 2005 CBA Playoffs to help lead Sioux Falls to the 2005 CBA Championship...only player in Skyforce history to record a triple-double in the postseason after posting 35 point, 10 rebounds and 10 assists against the Rockford Lightning in Game 2 of the 2005 CBA Finals...named 2004 CBA Rookie of the Year after averaging 12.9 points and 7.5 assist with the Idaho Stampede.

**College Highlights:** Named to the NABC Second Team All-District Team and Second-Team All-Horizon League selection his senior season...finished his career as the only player in LU history with 1,500 points, 500 assists and 150 steals.

**Senior (2002-03):** Had another outstanding campaign, averaging a team-best 18.4 ppg, 5.3 apg and 1.6 spg...also snagged 3.7 rpg.....amassed 400 points, 100 rebounds and 100 assists for the third straight campaign...was the Preseason Horizon League Player of the Year...member of Dick Vitale's All-Rip Van Winkle Team...shortest player in Loyola history to score 1,000 points...finished his career ranked third on the school's all-time list with 1,933 points...was one of only two player to rank in the top ten in the Horizon League in scoring, assists and steals.

**Junior (2001-02):** Put together arguably the best season by a Rambler in over a decade...finished 16th in the nation in scoring with 21.7 ppg...led the Horizon League in scoring and also ranked fourth in assists and third in steals...first Rambler since Keith Gales in 1991-92 to average over 20.0 ppg and to lead the league in scoring...earned first team all-district accolades from both the National Association of Basketball Coaches and the United States Basketball Writers Association...First Team All-Horizon League selection for second consecutive year...named to the College Insider.com Mid-Major All-America team...two-time Horizon League Player of the Week...scored in double digits in all but one game...registered at least 400 points, 100 rebounds and 100 assists for the second straight season.

**Sophomore (2000-01):** First Team All-MCC selection after leading team with 17.3 ppg and 6.1 apg...finished third in the MCC in scoring, second in steals and first in assists...became first sophomore to lead Loyola in scoring since Keith Gales in 1988-89...also is first Rambler to lead team in both scoring and assists since Carl Golston in 1985-86...became first LU sophomore to earn First Team All-MCC honors since Golston in 1984...is first Loyola player since Gales to tally 400 points, 100 rebounds and 100 assists in a season...ranked among national leaders in assists all season.

**Freshman (1999-00):** Finished third on the team in scoring (8.8 ppg) and led the club in assists (4.1 apg)...ranked third on the team in free throw percentage (.781).
