Pro Career Highlights: Played with the Canterbury Rams in New Zealand in the summer of 2007, averaging 19.2 points and 9.5 rebounds. Ranked 11th in the league in scoring and fourth in rebounding. Started the 2006-07 season in the Netherlands with Demon Astronauts Amsterdam before moving on to Mexico with Lobos Grises de la UAD Durango, averaging 10.3 points and 10.3 rebounds in three games. Also appeared in two games with the Quad City Riverhawks in the ABA, averaging 5.0 points. Played with the Arkansas ArchAngels in the WBA in the summer of 2006 (statistics unavailable). Spent the 2005-06 season in the CBA with the Albany Patrooms, averaging 6.5 points and 3.2 rebounds in 41 games. Spent the fall of 2005 with EA Sports playing exhibition games against NCAA opponents. Played in England with the Sheffield Sharks in 2004-05, averaging 6.9 points and 4.7 rebounds in seven games.

College Highlights: Named to the ACC All-Rookie Team as a freshman. Finished collegiate career ranked third on Florida State's all-time leaders in games played (120), 15th in steals (123), and 12th in three-point field goals made (92). Started 105 of 120 games played.

Senior (2003-04): Averaged 6.2 points and 3.7 rebounds in 22.4 minutes a contest. Started 30 of 33 games. Scored in double figures seven times. Recorded season-high 12 points vs. Savannah State and at Virginia. Pulled down a season-high seven rebounds twice, vs. Maine in the season opener and at Clemson.

Junior (2002-03): Averaged 8.5 points and 4.1 rebounds in 26.7 minutes a contest. Started 22 of 29 games. Scored in double figures 12 times. Scored season-high 19 points on 8-for-9 shooting vs. Iowa.

Sophomore (2001-02): Averaged 7.8 points and 4.7 rebounds in 26.0 minutes a contest. Started 23 of 28 games. Scored in double figures 12 times. Recorded a season-high 21 points vs. Birmingham Southern and Virginia Tech. Posted 12 points and seven rebounds vs. Duke. Scored ten points vs. North Carolina and recorded 12 points in the rematch.

Freshman (2000-01): Averaged 9.3 points and 6.0 rebounds. Started all 30 games. Scored in double figures 14 times. Recorded two double-doubles. Posted a career-high 22 points and pulled down ten rebounds vs. Cleveland State. Scored 12 points and grabbed ten rebounds vs. Rhode Island. Recorded 18 points on 7-for-8 shooting in the season opener vs. Florida.
