**Senior (2007-08):** Averaged 11.7 points and a team-high 5.8 rebounds. Started 32 of 34 games. Recorded career-high 21 points, including three made threes vs. Illinois-Chicago. Posted 16 points and nine rebounds at Baylor. Tallied 18 points and eight rebounds at East Carolina. Registered 19 points at Miami (Fla.). Notched a double-double of 15 points and a career-high-tying ten rebounds vs. Davidson. Scored 14 points and grabbed seven rebounds vs. UNC Asheville in the Big South Tournament championship game.

**Junior (2006-07):** Averaged 7.9 points and 3.8 rebounds in 18.3 minutes a contest. Started twice. Scored in double figures 12 times. Posted season-high 19 points on perfect 7-for-7 shooting at Northern Illinois. Registered first career double-double with 13 points and a career-high ten rebounds at Charleston Southern. Tallied 12 points, five rebounds, and a career-high five steals at Texas A&M. Recorded 14 points, nine rebounds, and a career-high seven assists at VMI. Scored 14 points vs. VMI in the Big South Tournament championship game.

**Sophomore (2005-06):** Averaged 4.2 points and 1.8 rebounds in 11.9 minutes a contest. Started six times. Recorded season-high 15 points twice, vs. Palm Beach Atlantic and Liberty. Pulled down a season-high six rebounds vs. VMI. Contributed nine points and five rebounds vs. High Point in the first round of the Big South Tournament.

**Freshman (2004-05):** Averaged 1.5 points and 0.6 rebounds in 4.3 minutes a contest. Tallied season-high 13 points on 6-for-9 shooting vs. Barton College. Scored six points in five minutes vs. Radford.
