College Highlights: Played in 100 games earning 44 starts ... averaged 7.6 points, 2.6 rebounds and 1.2 assists in 20.2 minutes

Senior (2008-09) LSU: Four games in double figures, 35 for his LSU career ... Best game of the season was against Grambling State (12/13) when he was 6-of-7 from the field and a perfect 4-of-4 from three-point range, scoring 16 points ... Scored 11 in the double overtime win at Mississippi State (2/11) after Bo Spencer got hurt and played 25 minutes against Ole Miss (2/14) in a starting role and scored 11 points ... Started three games this season, 36 for his career ... Averaged 4.6 points, 2.3 rebounds and 15.9 minutes of playing time per game ... Hit 24-of-68 three-pointers, 119 for his career ... Had a three and five points in the NCAA Tournament win over Butler (3/19).

Junior (2007-08) LSU: Started 17-of-31 games, averaging 24.3 minutes per game ... He was fourth on the team in scoring at 8.3 points per game, with an average of 2.5 rebounds and 1.6 assists ... Had 16 double-figure scoring games, giving him 31 at LSU in his two years here ... Best scoring game of the season was 19 points against Tulane in the New Orleans Arena ... Had 18 points at Arkansas on Feb. 20, hitting 6-of-13 field goals ... Played all 40 minutes against Oregon State (12/22), scoring 15 points ... Had a string of seven-straight double-figure games from Nov. 30 against Southern through the Tulane game (1/2) when he scored his high of 19 ... Rebound high of seven vs. Chaminade (11/20) ... Started the first 16 games of the season.

Sophomore (2005-06) LSU: Played in 24 games, starting 16, leading the team in three-point field goals with 52 (52-of-134, 38.8 percent) ... Averaged 29.2 minutes per game, averaging 10.5 points per game (third on the team) and 2.8 rebounds a game ... Scored in double figures in 15 of the games, topped by a 23-points performance against Auburn (1/13) ... In that game, hit 8-of-16 field goals and 5-of-9 three-pointers ... In a two-game streak, against Auburn and Ole Miss (1/17), Martin hit 13-of-26 field goals, 9-of-16 treys and scored 48 combined points ... Had season-high five assists at Ole Miss (2/14).

Freshman (2005-06) Texas Tech: Played 14 games for the Red Raiders, starting eight before moving back to his home state ... Averaged 7.4 points per game, 3.6 rebounds and 1.9 assists per game, while averaging 24.7 minutes ... He made 38 percent of his three-point attempts, 16-of-42 ... Scored in 13 games in his first collegiate effort against San Jose State, one of six double-figure games for the Red Raiders ... Season-best of 14 twice against Furman and TCU.

Personal: Parents are Terry, Sr., and Audwina Martin ... One brother, Keldric ... Dad played at Louisiana-Monroe and was a draft pick of the Atlanta Hawks of the NBA in 1984 and played 10 years of pro ball overseas ... Majored arts and sciences ...
