Pro Career Highlights: Named NBA Developmental League MVP in 2003-04 and earned First Team All-League honors in 2002-03 and 2003-04. Has played extensively domestically in the NBA and NBA D-League and has also played overseas. Finished the 2007-08 season in Italy with Cimberio Varese, averaging 9.8 points, 2.5 rebounds, and 2.7 assists in 17 games. Participated in training camp with the Golden State Warriors in the fall of 2008. Played with Eldo Basket Napoli in Italy in 2006-07, averaging 13.4 points, 2.8 rebounds, and 2.9 assists in ten Italian league games and 14.3 points, 2.8 rebounds, and 2.8 assists in six Euroleague games.

Spent the 2005-06 in the NBA Developmental League with the Albuquerque Thunderbirds, averaging 17.2 points, 4.7 rebounds, and 6.5 assists in 32 games. Participated in training camp with the Toronto Raptors in the fall of 2005. Played with the Los Angeles Lakers

in the NBA in 2004-05, averaging 4.4 points and 2.0 assists in 76 games. Spent most of the 2003-04 season with the North Charleston Lowgators in the NBA D-League, averaging 18.6 points, 3.3 rebounds, and 6.5 assists in 41 games. Received a call-up to the NBA by the New Orleans Hornets, averaging 2.0 points in three games. Spent the majority of the 2002-03 season in the NBA D-League with the North Charleston Lowgators, averaging 15.7 points, 3.8 rebounds, and 4.9 assists in 44 games. Received a call-up to the NBA by the Cleveland Cavaliers, averaging 4.3 points, 2.0 rebounds, and 2.6 assists in 15 games. Participated in training camp with the Houston Rockets in 2002. Played with the Rockets in 2001-02, averaging 3.1 points and 1.8 assists in 10.1 minutes a game.

College Highlights: Finished collegiate career at McNeese State as the eighth all-time leading scorer (1692 points) and third all-time assist leader (360) in school history. Received All-Southland Conference honors both his junior and senior seasons. Ranked in the Top 25 in nation in scoring his final two years.

Senior (2000-01): Averaged 20.1 points, 5.7 rebounds, and 3.6 assists. Finished second in the conference in scoring, to teammate Desmond Mallet. Led team in assists and free throw shooting. Led team in scoring 10 times. Notched a double-double with season-high 34 points and 13 rebounds against Sam Houston State. Scored 33 points and grabbed 10 rebounds at Texas-San Antonio. Tallied 29 points and 11 rebounds against Northwestern State.

Junior (1999-00): Averaged 22.0 points, 5.0 rebounds, and 4.5 assists. Led Southland Conference in scoring. Paced team in scoring in 18 games. Topped 30 points on six occasions, including a career-high of 38 points against Texas-San Antonio. Registered 35 points at Southwest Texas. Recorded a double-double with 30 points and 12 rebounds at West Virginia on Dec. 4.

Sophomore (1998-99): Averaged 5.0 points, 2.1 rebounds, and 2.1 assists in 14.7 minutes a game. Started twice in 26 games. Was slowed by an injury early in the season. Ranked fourth on the team in assists and was third in steals. Scored in double figures three times, with a season-high of 18 points against Lamar.

Freshman (1997-98): Averaged 13.3 points, 3.5 rebounds, and 2.9 assists. Started 24 of 26 games. Scoring averaged jumped to 14.0 points in league play. Registered two double-doubles. Scored season-high 24 points against Southeastern Louisiana. Dished out ten assists against Texas-San Antonio.
