College Highlights: Named to the Big 12 All-Newcomer Team as a sophomore. Finished collegiate career at Baylor after playing freshman season at Louisiana State. Sat out the second semester of 2003-04 and the first semester of 2004-05 at Baylor under NCAA transfer rules.

Senior (2006-07): Averaged 6.3 points and 4.0 rebounds in 20.8 minutes a contest. Missed five games late in the year due to a broken foot. Scored in double figures seven times. Registered season-high 17 points on 6-for-7 shooting, 3-for-3 on three-pointers vs. Angelo State in the season opener. Recorded a double-double of 14 points and ten rebounds vs. Prairie View A&M. Scored 14 points on 6-for-7 shooting vs. Alcorn State. Tallied 12 points at Oklahoma State. Matched a career high with 11 rebounds at Missouri. Scored ten points and grabbed seven rebounds at Iowa State.

Junior (2005-06): Averaged 3.4 points and 2.8 rebounds in 21.5 minutes a contest. Started all 17 games. Registered season-high 12 points in the season opener at Texas Tech. Registered season-high five rebounds on three different occasions, twice vs. Texas A&M and vs. Texas Tech. Scored eight points and dished out a season-high four assists vs. Kansas State.

Sophomore (2004-05): Averaged 12.7 points and 5.4 rebounds. Ranked second in the Big 12 in free throw shooting (.833). Started all 24 games after sitting out the first five games of the season. Scored 20 or more points three times. Recorded career highs of 23 points and 11 rebounds vs. Purdue. Sank three three-pointers on his way to 20 points at Texas. Posted 17 points and eight rebounds at Texas Tech. Scored 19 points and grabbed seven rebounds at Oklahoma State. Registered 14 points and six rebounds vs. Kansas. Tallied 15 points in his Baylor debut at SMU.

Freshman (2002-03): At LSU, averaged 0.7 points and 1.5 rebounds in 3.6 minutes a contest. Set season highs of six points and three rebounds vs. Centenary.
