Pro Career Highlights: Spent the 2007-08 season in Finland with Porvoon Tarmo, averaging 7.8 points, 3.2 rebounds, and 2.9 assists in 12 games.

College Highlights: Led team in assists and ranked in the Top Ten in the Mountain West Conference his freshman, sophomore, and junior seasons. Started 104 of 125 career games played.

Senior (2005-06): Averaged 2.2 points, 1.6 rebounds, and 1.3 assists in 15.7 minutes a contest. Started ten of 25 games. Recorded season-high eight points and four rebounds in the season opener vs. Texas State. Tallied five points and season-highs with seven rebounds and six assists at Weber State. Contributed five points, four rebounds, and three assists at Rice. Scored six points and dished out three assists vs. BYU.

Junior (2004-05): Averaged 4.7 points, 2.2 rebounds, and 3.2 assists (ranked sixth in the MWC) in 27.9 minutes a contest. Started 29 of 34 games. Scored in double figures four times. Registered season-high 16 points on 5-for-9 shooting, 4-for-6 from three-point range vs. Colorado. Tallied 14 points, four assists, and four steals at Colorado State. Recorded 13 points on 4-for-5 shooting at Wyoming. Posted nine points, six assists, and a career-high five steals at Cal Poly.

Sophomore (2003-04): Averaged 6.1 points, 3.7 rebounds, and 3.6 assists (sixth in the MWC) in 28.8 minutes a contest. Also ranked seven in the league in free throw percentage (.789). Started 32 of 33 games. Scored in double figures five times. Recorded career-high 24 points at Colorado State. Tallied 14 points, five rebounds, and four assists vs. UNLV. Posted 14 points and a season-high seven rebounds vs. BYU. Dished out a season-high eight assists to go with nine points at Colorado. Scored 13 points vs. Boston College in the NCAA Tournament.

Freshman (2002-03): Averaged 4.6 points, 3.1 rebounds, and 3.1 assists (seventh in the MWC) in 21.4 minutes a contest. Set a school freshman record for free throw percentage (.810). Started all 33 games. Scored in double figures four times. Hit all four shots including three three-pointers in scoring a season-high 17 points vs. UNLV. Tallied 11 points, a season-high seven assists, and five rebounds vs. Northern Iowa. Posted first career double-double with 11 points and ten rebounds vs. Ripon. Registered 11 points and five rebounds vs. New Mexico.
