Pro Career Highlights: Started the 2006-07 season with FC Kaiserslautern in the German 2.Bundesliga, averaging 11.2 points and 4.2 rebounds in 13 games. Moved on to the Limerick Lions Basketball Club in Ireland, averaging 26.0 points, 3.1 rebounds, 2.9 assists, and 2.6 steals in ten games.

College Highlights: Named Atlantic Sun Defensive Player of the year his junior and senior seasons. Also earned Second Team All-Conference honors as a junior. Finished collegiate career at Gardner-Webb after playing one and a half seasons at Pensacola Junior College in Florida. Did not play basketball during the 2003-04 season while concentrating on academics.

Senior (2005-06): Averaged 11.1 points, 3.8 rebounds, and 2.2 assists. Started all 29 games. Scored in double figures 17 times. Registered a career-high-matching 28 points on 9-for-13 shooting, 6-for-8 from three-point range at East Tennessee State. Tallied 20 points, six rebounds, four assists, and four steals at North Carolina. Scored 22 points at Mercer. Recorded a double-double of 13 points and a season-high ten rebounds at Jacksonville. Posted 14 points and seven rebounds at UNC Greensboro. Distributed a career-high seven assists vs. Mercer.

Junior (2004-05): Averaged 12.6 points, 4.2 rebounds, and 2.6 assists. Led conference in steals (2.6 spg), the 11th best single-season mark in league history. Scored 20 or more points four times, posting a career-high 28 points vs. Stetson. Scored 21 points and grabbed four steals at Georgia. Tallied 19 points, a career-high 12 rebounds, six assists, and a career-high six steals vs. Lipscomb. Posted 16 points, nine rebounds, and five steals at Belmont. Registered 20 points, five rebounds, four assists, and four steals vs. East Carolina.

Sophomore (2002-03): Appeared in 18 games before being declared academically ineligible after the first semester. Led team with 21 points vs. Atlanta Metropolitan and posted 24 points in the rematch.

Freshman (2001-02): Averaged 13.0 points, 3.2 rebounds, and 3.6 assists. Earned Honorable Mention All-Panhandle Conference honors.
